## **PROJECT UPDATE: Edwards Interchange**

## For the Week of October 10, 2010

As you know, last week ACC focused our efforts on the westbound on-ramp which should reopen tomorrow, Saturday, October 9, 2010. We had anticipated closing the eastbound off-ramp during next week's construction window but have now put that off until Tuesday 10/19 to accommodate our paving contractor. This week should be relatively tame with no major closures, just intermittent flagging within the work zone and potential delays.

Similar to previous weeks ACC will be working within the roadway performing concrete paving, sidewalk and wall construction. During non-peak regular work hours there will continue to be flagger manned lane closures between the Miller Ranch Road intersection and the eastbound on/off ramps of I-70. We encourage commuters to consider an alternate route other than Edwards exit 163 during regular business hours (9 a.m. - 4 p.m.) to avoid the inherent delays that may be experienced in the construction zone.

As stated earlier, ACC does not anticipate a closure of the eastbound off-ramp until Tuesday October, 19. The closure will last 5 days, 24-hours per day.
