

EDWARDS INTERCHANGE PROJECT UPDATE june 13, 2010



Work, work, work...

- The weather has been great and ACC has enjoyed great progress in the months of May and June.
- Crews will be installing sanitary sewerline within Beard Creek road this week close to the I-70 interchange. This work will require ACC to reduce traffic to one-lane during the day with flaggers manning the traffic flow.
- The rest of the traffic will remain unchanged on the west side of the Edwards Access Road and the south side of Miller Ranch road with one lane of thru-traffic in each direction with auxiliary turn lanes.
- Crews continue to work on the Berry Creek realignment, walls under the viaduct and along the west bound off-ramp, installing conduit along Miller Ranch road and preparing for temporary paving.

BASIC PROJECT INFORMATION

Project schedule: March 15 - November 19, 2010.

Scope: Construction of four roundabouts: Two at the I-70 interchange, one at Miller Ranch Road & Edwards Access Road, and one at the intersection of Berry Creek/Beard Creek Roads. Work also includes bike/ pedestrian paths along much of the corridor.

Traffic Impacts: There will always be one lane of thru traffic on Miller Ranch Road and the Edwards Access Road going in each direction during peak hours, plus auxiliary turn lanes. Peak hours are 7-9 a.m. and 4-7 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Funding: This project is funded by the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009
