Flagger Manned Lane Closure Monday, May 16 at 7 a.m. to Tuesday night, May 17

Traffic will again be **limited to a single lane** from the Eagle River Bridge to Miller Ranch Road Monday, May 16 at 7 a.m. to Tuesday night, May 17. The single lane will be manned 24 hours per day by flaggers who will alternate traffic in order to minimize delays.

From Wednesday through the end of the week, traffic will be limited to periodic delays throughout the project as crews work to replace concrete pavement in the roadway. Crews will also be working on permanent striping, construction of sidewalks, curb & gutter, installation of light poles, guardrail work, and signage. This work may require flagger manned traffic control during construction hours but there will always be one lane of traffic flowing in each direction. ACC is scheduled to be off the site by June 6, 2011.

Construction Hours: Sunrise - 7 p.m. Monday - Friday with potential work on Saturday.
