## Project-specific Roadway and Lane Closure Strategy

### Purpose

These report documents analyses of the periods when I-70 traffic can be disrupted for construction activities and preparatory efforts related to widening the eastbound Twin Tunnel. I-70 traffic is highly variable depending on season, month, day of the week, and direction. These factors have been considered in developing strategies for closing I-70 to all traffic or for closing only one lane. It is intended to provide initial guidance based on historic traffic patterns. It is anticipated that modification will be made as necessary to respond to actual traffic conditions or the nature of the specific work efforts. Two primary types of disruptions have been considered:

- Full road closures where all I-70 traffic is stopped in one or both directions for up to 30 minutes.
- Lane closures where one lane may be closed for an extended period of time.

Blasting activities will be conducted in the spring and summer of 2013 and will require full roadway closures in both directions of durations lasting between 15 (eastbound) and 30 minutes (westbound). Blasts may occur four to six times a day with no schedule that can be determined many days in advance. Rockfall exploration, mitigation, and protection activities will be occur above and beside the tunnel portals and could require full roadway closures in one or both directions of durations lasting approximately 20 minutes. These activities must occur during daylight hours and will be limited to weekdays (Monday through Thursday) only.

Tunnel construction-related activities that will begin in 2012 would involve single lane closures for extended periods of time could include geotechnical investigations and pillar stabilization in both tunnels. In addition, single lane closures may be necessary for tunnel repairs in the westbound direction. Roadway widening and shoulder work in the eastbound direction (outside the tunnel) during 2012 and 2013 will also require closures of one lane that could be in place for multiple weekdays.

In general, the lane closure windows have been increased in coordination with CDOT Region 1 Traffic staff when compared to those found in the *CDOT Region 1 Lane Closure Strategy – Second Edition*, 2008. This modified schedule recognizes the critical nature and time constraints of the Twin Tunnels Widening project.

It is anticipated that traffic volumes will be monitored continuously through the construction period. This will allow CDOT Region 1 construction managers and the contractor (Kraemer/Obayashi) to react quickly to actual traffic patterns and modify closure activities to minimize traffic disruptions while maximizing the time available for construction.

## **General Methodology and Assumptions**

The analyses that were conducted for this strategy are based on the following methodology and assumptions:

- Traffic Volumes – CDOT maintains an automatic traffic recorder (ATR) station on I-70 at the west end of the Twin Tunnels. The ATR records hourly volumes for every day of the year. This analysis is based on the time period from November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011. A review of monthly volumes since October 2011 has shown very little growth (or lower volumes) in the most recent eight months on I-70. Only June 2012 had an increase worth noting (7.7%). For each month, days were grouped into four categories and averaged: weekdays (Monday through Thursday), Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Each category has a distinct average hourly pattern of volumes in each direction.
- Capacities – Based on previous analysis efforts for the Twin Tunnels Environmental Assessment, the I-70 Reversible Lane project, and recent field experience, the following assumptions were made about roadway and lane capacities:
  - EB and WB Roadway (outside of the tunnels) - 4,000 vehicles per hour (vph)
  - EB and WB Tunnels – 3,200 vph
  - EB Detour (using game check road and CR 314) – 2,700 vph (based on VISSIM model results)
  - One lane closure (outside of tunnels) – 1,600 vph
  - One lane closure (in either tunnel) – 1,100 vph (based on recent field experience )
  - One lane closure on the EB Detour – 1,200 vph
- Road Closure Capacity – The capacity reduction for a road closure is proportional to the time involved. Thus, a 30-minute closure in the eastbound direction results in a capacity of 1,600 vph during that hour to clear two lanes of traffic through the tunnel.
- Queue Clearance – The performance measure that is the basis for this strategy is that it will be acceptable for traffic queues resulting from a road closure to clear within one hour of the road reopening. The maximum delay for any vehicle in the queue will not exceed 15, 20, or 30 minutes – depending on the closure activity. Thus, if traffic is expected to take longer than one hour to return to normal speeds, no construction activity will be allowed until volumes decrease in subsequent hours such that there is compliance with the one hour standard. This is particularly important on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays when in one or both directions are experiencing their peaks.

## **Lane Closure Strategies for Various Construction Activities**

Allowable times (and by inference prohibited times) for the various activities have been summarized for each month (see **Appendix A**). These tables were developed to aid Kraemer-Obayashi (the CM/GC contractor) in developing work schedules and cost estimates for the various construction efforts. **Appendix A** provides a summary of the findings from the various analyses discussed in the following sections.

There are a number of construction activities that could require one lane to be closed, potentially involving mainline I-70, either tunnel, or the eastbound detour. These closures could be independently scheduled since activities in one direction would not normally affect traffic in the opposite direction.

### **Lane Closures Outside of the Tunnels**

One of the two eastbound lanes can be closed for extended periods of time according to a schedule established by Region 1 Traffic staff in an email dated April 18, 2012. This email stated that closures will be allowed from 11:00 pm Sunday through 10:00 am Friday (see **Table 1**). This determination is focused on weekdays.

The schedule for closing one of the two westbound lanes for extended periods of time was developed based on the schedule established by Region 1 Traffic staff for the eastbound direction. The weekday closures were modified slightly in recognition of the different nature of weekend traffic in the westbound direction. Closures are allowed from 6:00 pm Sunday through 7:00 am Friday (see **Table 1**).

Due to the capacity restrictions observed when a lane is closed in either of the tunnels, **Table 1** assumes that these periods apply to lane closures outside of the tunnels. These closures would be related to construction activities such as retaining wall construction and adding the third lane.

Region 1 Traffic staff's general directive was further refined by determining periods that might experience congestion during weekdays and also analyzing weekend (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) periods where lane closures could be allowed, if necessary. Average hourly volumes for each month were tabulated by direction from the ATR data and are shown in **Appendix B**. Yellow highlights have been added to show when average hourly volumes exceed the 1,600 vph capacity level established for lane closures outside the tunnels. These tabulations show that some months have weekday volumes higher than 1,600 vph and could experience congestion for several hours in the morning (westbound) and in the afternoon (eastbound). July has the highest average hourly volumes and has the most potential for congestion. Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays have higher volumes so there are more restrictive hours. The tabulations in **Appendix A** identify these periods when lane closures must be avoided, if at all possible.

### **Lane Closures Through the Tunnels**

There are a number of activities in each of the tunnels that must be accomplished before blasting can begin. These efforts include a variety of geotechnical investigations, pillar stabilization,

filling voids in the westbound tunnel, etc. Based on the observed one-lane capacity of 1,100 vph through the tunnels when equipment is parked or active in the tunnel, these activities would generally not be allowed during daytime hours. Specific hours when work is not allowed for each direction during each month are provided in **Appendix A**. The hourly tabulations shown in **Appendix C** provide volumes with yellow highlights identifying those that are more than 1,100 vph. In general, closures can generally be allowed between 9:00 pm and 8:00 am in the eastbound direction and between 9:00 pm and 6:00 am in the westbound direction.

## **Road Closure Strategies for Various Construction Activities**

Blasting is the principal activity that will require closing I-70 to all traffic at the Twin Tunnels. As described in the following discussion, these closures will stop westbound traffic for longer periods (up to 30 minutes). Although eastbound traffic will be on a detour to bypass the tunnel, it will be stopped for up to 15 minutes as a safety precaution for each blast. These blasts and resulting closures will generally occur four to six times a day. Each direction of traffic was analyzed separately utilizing five-minute periods to more precisely determine the queue dissipation characteristics of individual average day.

### **Eastbound Road Closures for Blasting**

Both eastbound lanes will need to be closed when there is blasting in the eastbound tunnel. Once the widening activities have proceeded sufficient distance inside the west portal, it may be possible that full road closures are no longer be necessary. However, the 15-minute closure schedule shown in **Table 2** (and also provided in **Appendix A**) assumes that eastbound traffic will be disrupted throughout the widening process (March 2013 through October 2013). The restrictions take into account the capacity of the detour (2,700 vph). In general, the periods when no closures would be allowed represent times when traffic is rising or already at such a high level that queues cannot be dissipated within an hour. In addition, **Table 2** identifies the combined restrictions based on both directions.

### **Westbound Road Closures for Blasting**

Both westbound lanes will need to be closed throughout the blasting/widening process for the eastbound tunnel. Westbound traffic must be kept out of the tunnel when a blast is set off and for a sufficient period afterward (up to 30 minutes total) so that the integrity of the tunnel can be evaluated. **Table 2** provides the times that no closures would be allowed from March through October by day of the week. The restrictions are based on the capacity of the tunnel (3,200 vph). In general, the periods when no closures would be allowed represent times when traffic is rising or already at such a high level that queues cannot be dissipated within an hour.

### **Roadway and Lane Closures related to Holiday Periods**

During the tunnel widening period in 2013, there will be three holiday periods that will have high traffic volumes: Memorial Day (May 27<sup>th</sup>), Fourth of July (Thursday), and Labor Day (September 2<sup>nd</sup>). **Table 3** provides schedules for these three holidays. Since July 4<sup>th</sup> is a Thursday, traffic volumes from 2007 (when July 4<sup>th</sup> was on a Wednesday) were utilized since this is the most recent year that the holiday didn't involve a Friday through Monday.

### **Road Closures for Other Construction Activities**

During the summer and fall of 2012, there will be occasions when both tunnels are closed for up to 20 minutes for rockfall mitigation activities at the portals of the tunnels. During the last week of July, an investigation was conducted to identify rocks that have potential to fall due to blasts. Traffic was stopped at 6:00am, 8:00am and 10:00am. Field observations during these four days showed that the disruptions during these times were minor and were within the anticipated parameters. These closures also provided a test of the proposed method of handling traffic (MOT) for the later blasting closures. More details of these activities are contained in a separate report: *Summary of Traffic Operations during July 2012 Rockfall Investigation at the Twin Tunnels*.

Geotechnical investigations inside the eastbound tunnel were conducted in late August 2012 during night time hours. This procedure was unique in that traffic was stopped for 30 minute periods, and then the one equipment remained in the tunnel while only one lane was available to clear traffic through the tunnel. This work began at 11:00 pm and was completed by 4:00 am. There one 1½ hour separations between the start times of the closures. There were no reported traffic problems during this work.

There will be rock scaling at the tunnel portals during the fall of 2012 to remove all of the loose material found during July. The 20 minute closure schedules for these early activities during September through December are provided in **Appendix A**. Periods utilizing one hour separations of the start of closures and also 1½ hour separations are shown. If a high volume of rock is dislodged at one time, it is possible that clean up cannot be completed within the 20 minutes allotted for the closure. For this case, 30-minute closures are also included in the tabulation.

### **Potential Queues during Road Closures**

Maximum queue lengths have been calculated for both directions of traffic and are shown on in **Table 2**. A secondary objective in analyzing allowable hours for closures is to keep the lengths of queues stopped for blasting to a reasonable length. Procedures for stopping traffic were tested during the rock fall investigations in late July 2012. The primary stopping point for eastbound traffic will be west of the west Idaho Springs interchange (Exit 239). This will minimize the potential for disruptions to local traffic on Miner Street and Colorado Avenue in Idaho Springs. Westbound traffic will be stopped at the Hyland Hills interchange (Exit 246). The approach to this location has three lanes and is on an uphill grade, so this is felt to be the safest location to stop traffic. Secondary closure points will be established approximately 1,000 feet outside each tunnel. **Table 4** shows the distances upstream of the Twin Tunnels and also upstream of the anticipated closure points. With the possible exception of Sundays in September, a comparison of **Tables 2 and 4** shows that eastbound queues will generally be contained east of Empire Junction where US 40 enters I-70. Queues of westbound traffic will generally be west of the Evergreen interchange (Exit 251). Saturday morning's in July and August have the potential for longer queues but the option of leading the queue down Floyd Hill to the Hidden Valley interchange (Exit 243) at low speeds to provide more distance for queues will be explored.

### **Considerations for Modifying Road Closures Schedules**

It should be remembered that the closure schedules provided in **Appendix A**, **Table 2**, and **Table 3** were primarily developed for construction planning purposes. They are based on average monthly hourly volumes for each category of day. Thus, any day or hour in 2012 or 2013 is likely to deviate from this average.

To compensate for this uncertainty of actual conditions in the future, it is anticipated that traffic volumes will be monitored continuously through the construction period. This will allow CDOT Region 1 construction managers and the contractor (Kraemer-Obayashi) to react quickly to actual traffic patterns and modify closure activities to minimize traffic disruptions while maximizing the time available for construction activities. Recent past historical counts (hourly by direction) will be available for review on a week-by-week (or even day-by-day) basis so that volumes can be anticipated.

The following potential scenario describes how historic and contemporary data can be utilized in on-going blasting operations. At 8:00am on a Saturday in June, a blast is ready to be fired. Table 1 shows that westbound traffic is the only consideration since eastbound traffic is too low to be of concern. Historic and current westbound traffic volumes for the last four hours would be compared to see whether current volumes are rising at a lower or higher rate than in the past. If traffic is lower, CDOT and the contractor may decide that the blast can be set off because past experience has shown that traffic will be able to clear in sufficient time so that there is not a queue throughout the rest of the morning and early afternoon.
