I-70 VAIL UNDERPASS | PHASE 3

NOV. 18 - APRIL 2017

What:

This phase consists of a winter slowdown of major construction to allow for a normal traffic alignment along the North and South Frontage Roads during the winter tourism season.


There is the potential for minor construction activities beneath the underpass, although no night or week work is anticipated during Phase 3.

Traffic Impact:

The Frontage Roads function as their normal twoway operation through the construction site, allowing eastbound and westbound travel on both the North and South Frontage Roads. I-70 is in its normal two-lane, two-way traffic alignment. The new underpass will be closed during Phase 3 for both vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

Bikes and Pedestrians:

Access to the Gore Creek Trail on the east end of the project site (adjacent to the Glen Lyon Offices) is open to pedestrians and bicyclists. South Frontage Road pedestrians are advised to use the Gore Creek Trail. Adjacent to the North Frontage Road, the North Recreation Path is open in its new at-grade alignment.
