



I-25 ILEX STREET TO CITY CENTER DRIVE



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) began work on the I-25 Ilex Street to City Center Drive project in July 2015. The project consists of replacing bridges on I-25 between Ilex Street and City Center Drive in Pueblo. Work also includes rehabilitation of bridges on northbound I-25 over Santa Fe Avenue (US 50C), I-25 over Indiana Avenue, on Santa Fe Avenue over the Arkansas River, and on Northern Avenue and Mesa Avenue over I-25. Local roadway improvements are included at D Street, Bennett Street, Clark Street, and along Santa Fe Avenue.

PROJECT PROGRESS

"Two years after the groundbreaking, the I-25/Ilex Street to City Center Drive project construction is progressing smoothly," the project team stated.

Construction progress has seen two major traffic shifts on I-25, where both directions were shifted into a temporary configuration onto the new northbound alignment which has allowed Phase 2 of construction to begin.

Previous bridge viaducts are currently undergoing demolition with a total of 53 spans being removed from the north viaducts over Gruma Drive and the railroad, and the south viaducts over D Street and Thomas Phelps Creek Trail.

- Roadway and structural work on the I-25 bridge over Indiana Avenue complete.
- Mesa bridge over I-25 structure, signing and roadway complete.
- Northern Avenue bridge complete.
- MSE wall along southbound I-25 on-ramp from Santa Fe Avenue complete.
- MSE walls for phase 1 complete.
- Pond A grading and concrete flatwork by Gruma Drive complete.
- Storm drainage installation for phase 1 of project


SCHEDULE AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Normal working hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Some night time work is expected to occur until November. Speeds have been reduced to 25 MPH on Northern Ave.-Elm St. to Taylor Ave (eastbound and westbound) and southbound Santa Fe Ave. Locust St. to Santa Fe Dr.
