

Three-week construction break on the Leetsdale Drive resurfacing project

What is happening on the project?

Beginning May 22, construction on the Leetsdale Drive Resurfacing Project will temporarily pause for three weeks and will resume mid-June. Crews have completed all concrete work on Leetsdale Drive and will take a three-week break before starting resurfacing work.

What are the expected travel impacts?

When work resumes on mid-June, motorists can expect overnight closures Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction during resurfacing.

As crews resurface eastbound Leetsdale Drive, traffic will be shifted into the westbound lanes, with one lane open in each direction. This traffic pattern will be repeated for westbound resurfacing, and traffic will shift into the eastbound lanes, with one lane open in each direction. Crews will begin resurfacing Leetsdale Drive at Mississippi Avenue and work westbound to Colorado Boulevard.



There will be no speed reductions or oversize/overweight restrictions.

When are crews working?

- During resurfacing work, motorists should expect overnight lane closures and traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Nighttime lane closure hours are Sunday through Thursday:
 - \circ Northbound: 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - o Southbound: 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

When should the project be complete?

Work is expected to be complete by the beginning of August, weather dependent.
