

ADA ramp improvements on CO 141 in Clifton start Oct. 19

PROJECT OVERVIEW

In October, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor KSK, LLC will implement phase three of the ADA ramp improvements in Mesa County. In Clifton, work will begin Oct. 12 and will take place along E $\frac{1}{2}$ Road, Colorado Highway 141 (32 Road) and I-70B. The project will replace existing sidewalk curb ramps located at fifteen intersections along the three roadways.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled for October 19 and is expected to last until early November. Normal working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Travelers by car, bike, wheelchair or foot can expect various lane and sidewalk closures where work zones exist, during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.
- Sidewalks are likely to be closed overnight or over weekends to allow the concrete to set up.
- Access to all businesses will be maintained but may be temporarily altered.
