Mesa County ADA Ramps Phase III - Clifton

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

The Mesa County ADA Ramps Phase III Project will be conducted in Clifton along E $\frac{1}{2}$ Road, from Beverly Lane to 32 Road, on CO 141 (32 Road) from Bunting Avenue to Hall Avenue, and on Nottingham Drive, and on I-70B from E $\frac{1}{2}$ Road to the Peach Tree Shopping Center Entrance.

Monday, Oct. 26 to Friday, Oct. 30 work will consist of:

- Eastbound right lane closure on I-70B from CO 141 to E $\frac{1}{2}$ Rd.
 - $\circ~$ Expect intermittent flagging on the southside of CO 141, 32 Rd. and on the northside of CO 141, and E $\frac{1}{2}$ Rd.
- Westbound right lane closure on E ½ Rd. from 32 Rd. to Beverly Ln.
 - Expect intermittent flagging at Beverly Ln., Villa St., 31 ³/₄ Rd., and 32 Rd.
- All intersections will maintain public access
