

ADA ramp improvements on US 40 in Collbran start October 12

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Starting October 12, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor KSK, LLC will implement phase three of the ADA ramp improvements on Colorado Highway 330 in the town of Collbran, in Mesa County. The project will replace existing sidewalk curb ramps located at three intersections along CO 330 (High Street).

Affected intersections along CO 330 (High Street)
Orchard Ave. Elm Ave. 59 ½ RD.



PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled for Oct. 12 and is expected to last until Oct. 16. Normal working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Travelers by car, bike, wheelchair or foot can expect various lane and sidewalk closures where work zones exist, during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.
- Sidewalks are likely to be closed overnight or over weekends to allow the concrete to set up.
- Access to all businesses will be maintained but may be temporarily altered.
