DEFINITION OF NO-ACTION NETWORK



August 24, 2004

This No-Action network definition identifies the capacity improvements included in the No-Action alternative and used in the travel demand forecasting efforts. The No-Action Alternative will include these improvements as well as committed safety improvements, bike and pedestrian facilities, and travel demand management measures.

Inside the Study Area

The No-Action Alternative consists of the existing and committed transportation system network within the study area. Specifically:

- > existing roadway and transit facilities open for use as of 2004
- > committed capacity improvement projects that have funding dentified in regional, city, and county improvement programs, including:
 - Colorado Department of Transportation's 2005-2010 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
 - o North Front Range Metropolitan Planning Organization's 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TP)

 Regional Transportation District 2005-2010 Transit Development Program (TDP)

 Denver Regional Council of Governments' 2005-2010 Transportation

 - Improvement Program (TIP)County Capital Improvement Programs (CIPs)


 - o Municipal Capital Improvement Programs (CIPs); and
- committed capacity projects that have a dedicated source of funds such as:
 - o RTD's FasTracks Plan If voters approve the FasTracks referendum in November 2004, the No-Action network will include planned FasTracks transit projects.
 - 7th Pot Projects—Widening of I-25 between SH 7 and SH 66, including the modification of interchanges, overpasses, and frontage roads, was one of the state's 28 Strategic Investment Program projects. The section of I-25 from SH to SH 32 is expected to be complete in the fall of 2004. Final design is complete for the section from SH 52 to SH 119 and preliminary design is complete for the section from SH 119 to SH 66. All three sections will be included in the No-Action network.

Outside the Study Area

The transportation model includes the North Front Range MPO travel model and the DRCOG travel model. Together, these models encompass an area larger than the project's study area. The No-Action Alternative will include planned projects identified in the 2030 fiscally constrained regional transportation plans for the modeling area outside of the study area.

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No-Action Network Coding

The following steps were used to code the 2030 No-Action network for the North I-25 travel model:

- The No-Action network is defined to consist of the existing, committed, and/or funded transportation system network within the study area. See "Definition of No-Action Network" for the complete definitional description.¹
- Committed roadway capacity improvement projects were obtained from the STIP, TIP, and CIPs.² These projects are listed in Table 1.
- The 2030 No-Action network for the combined North I-25 model was developed by merging the following two TransCAD networks from the MPO models:
 - The 2010 network from NFRMPO. This network consists of the existing and committed projects in the NFRMPO model region. The North I-25 study area includes the entire NFRMPO model region.
 - The 2030 RTP network from DRCOG. RTP improvement projects in the North I-25 study area are removed from the network. Table 2 lists the 2030 RTP projects removed from the study area, and the specific coding action. Figure 1 depicts the location of the removed improvements in the resulting network.
- The combined network was reviewed to confirm that the committed projects were properly coded. Table 1 lists the committed projects and the specific coding action, and Figure 1 depicts the locations where coding modifications were made.

No-Action Network Coding

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The existing transit routes in the NFR area were added to the DRCOG 2030 RTP FasTracks transit network, to form a future noaction transit network.
