



Traffic Update - July 26 - July 29 **REVISED**

Region 3 Wrong Way Detection Project - I70 Mountain Corridor

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

The Region 3 Wrong Way Detection Project will be conducted at 87 off-ramp locations along I-70, starting at Exit 205 in Silverthorne and moving west to complete at Exit 2 in Rabbit Valley.

Monday, July 26 to Thursday, July 29 work will consist of:

- Monday, July 26
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent single lane/shoulder closures at Exit 167, 168, 163, 157, 147, 140 off-ramps
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent ramp closures at Exit 167, 168, 163, 157, 147, 140 off-ramps
- Tuesday, July 27
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent single lane/shoulder closures at Exit 133, 129, 121, and 119 off-ramps
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent ramp closures at Exit 133, 129, 121, and 119 off-ramps
- Wednesday, July 28
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent single lane/shoulder closures at Exit 140, 147, 157, and 163 off-ramps
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent ramp closures at Exit 140, 147, 157, and 163 off-ramps
- Thursday, July 29
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent single lane/shoulder closures at Exit 121, 129, 133, and 116 off-ramps
 - Eastbound and Westbound intermittent ramp closures at Exit 121, 129, 133, and 116 off-ramps
 - Eastbound intermittent ramp closures/shoulder closures at Exit 125 off-ramp
- Expect intermittent flagging and lane shifts during construction
- SCHEDULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE DUE TO WEATHER, EQUIPMENT, MATERIAL AND OTHER ROADWAY PROJECTS ALONG I-70
