

Change of closure dates for Lena Street: April 13, 2016

Folk singer Roger Miller once said, "Some people walk in the rain, others just get wet."

ACC can tell by the forecast that closing Lena Street on Wednesday evening would only produce one good day of work before the rain arrives - probably not worth the pain of having the road closed for the weekend. For this reason we'll be switching up the schedule that was advertised last Friday. ACC will postpone the closing of Lena Street until Monday, April 18, 2016 (tax day). The closure on Lena will be from SH 62 north, ending just before the Clinton Street intersection assuring the intersection will remain open. This plan, of course, is weather dependent.

Stay Alert! Flaggers will be initiating occasional traffic holds on SH 62 at Railroad Street as trucks deliver materials for the parking lot. This will occur during standard construction hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Traffic holds will be minimal and should not exceed 5 minutes. Pedestrians and bicyclists should use marked crosswalks and sidewalks to access the park and businesses on Lena.

One Final Note: The Town of Ridgway and CenturyLink are doing utility work in the local streets independent from of the Ramp Up Ridgway! project. ACC will endeavor to coordinate with this team in order to minimize impacts.

Please be alert to personnel in the work zone and drive slow through the cone zone!
