Project Update for April 24, 2016



I think our production for the week really demonstrated the phrase “weather permitting” as crews mucked their way through a partial workweek after our 3 day storm. The saturation of the ground limited production on the new parking lot but allowed us to make headway with the drainage in the first block of North Lena.

Thankfully, the sun is out now and work has really picked up as we near the end of the week. Not wanting to lose that momentum we intend to work through Saturday for the next couple of weeks allowing us to still achieve the May 6 reopening of the first block of Lena Street north of SH 62. Weather permitting... we will open the new parking lot at Railroad Street and SH 62 by the end of the day Wednesday, April 27, 2016.

Crews will start on the second stretch of North Lena Street on Thursday, April 28. Once this closure is in place access to the post office will be limited to foot traffic with parking available at Hartwell Park or on Clinton Street. For your safety, please follow the direction of the flaggers and signs and only cross Lena Street in designated areas.

Saturday is the Annual Clean Up Day for the Ridgway town residents. Dumpsters will be provided in the parking lot north of the library off Railroad Street from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. ACC will not be performing construction in this area and Railroad Street will be fully open to two-way traffic.

Stay Alert! Monday and Tuesday, flaggers will be initiating occasional traffic holds on SH 62 at Railroad Street as we finalize the opening of the parking lot. This will occur during standard construction hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Traffic holds will be minimal and should not exceed 5 minutes. Pedestrians and bicyclists should use marked crosswalks and sidewalks to access the park and businesses on Lena.

One Final Note: The Town of Ridgway and CenturyLink are doing utility work in the local streets independent from of the Ramp Up Ridgway! project. They are working with ACC in order to minimize impacts.

Please be alert to personnel in the work zone and drive slow through the cone zone!
