## Project Update: Week ending July 16, 2016



With another fabulous holiday week behind us, ACC is looking forward to a productive work week as we make progress on the CO 62 Ramp Up Ridgway Project.

The shift in traffic on CO 62 onto the shoofly has begun. You will start seeing concrete barriers put in place between the bridge and Liddell Street within the upcoming days. Crews will now begin excavating for the pipe installation. This work will require intermittent single lane closures in addition to the traffic shift while equipment mobilizes in/out of the work zone. Please use caution and patience as you navigate this new configuration.

The reconstruction of Rail Road Street from CO 62 to Charles Street will prompt intermittent closures on Monday and Tuesday with full closures to follow. We anticipate this closure to be in place into August. Crews will work with the town to accommodate traffic and vendors for **Thursday's concert in the park featuring the Hip Abduction and Niceness.** We hope to see you there!

Crews will continue to perform final prep work in the intersection of Clinton and Cora in preparation for paving which will occur July 13 or 14. This work will require spot closures within the intersection from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. with the exception of Thursday when we'll clear out a little early.

There is plenty to do after hours next week: "Raiders of the Lost Ark" at the Sherb on Tuesday; the Town Council meeting on Wednesday night; and, the Hip Abduction and Niceness in the Park on Thursday. Please encourage residents and visitors to respect the construction signage and fencing as its in place to assure safe passage of the public.
