Will it be rain? Will it be snow? Does it last through Monday?

There are so many questions regarding this weekend's storm that it makes it difficult to predict ACC's work week which begins Sunday April 17, 2016. Assuming the storm clears out to allow work on Monday, ACC will open the new parking lot adjacent to Hartwell Park off of Railroad Street on Tuesday, April 19th. The completion of this work will allow ACC to begin the drainage and roadwork on north Lena Street on Monday. Monday – Wednesday the closure on north Lena Street will be reduced to one lane of traffic with no street parking. This will be followed by a full closure of north Lena Street from SH 62 to just inside the intersection of Clinton Street. This means the intersection at Clinton Street is open as well as access to the post office roundabout from Clinton or Charles. We are working with the Post Master to determine the best plan for mail deliveries during the next stretch of Lena Street which will begin April 28th from Clinton Street north to Charles Street.

Stay Alert! Monday and Tuesday, flaggers will be initiating occasional traffic holds on SH 62 at Railroad Street as we finalize the opening of the parking lot. This will occur during standard construction hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Traffic holds will be minimal and should not exceed 5 minutes. Pedestrians and bicyclists should use marked crosswalks and sidewalks to access the park and businesses on Lena.

One Final Note: The Town of Ridgway and CenturyLink are doing utility work in the local streets independent from of the Ramp Up Ridgway! project. They are working with ACC in order to minimize impacts.

Please be alert to personnel in the work zone and drive slow through the cone zone!
