



CO 24 East Manitou Avenue Overlay Project

Project Information

In late September the Colorado Department of Transportation started a roadway reconstruction project at US 24 - Manitou Avenue, the intersection of Garden of the Gods Place and CO 24 East. The project consists of an asphalt overlay on Manitou Avenue along with drainage, guardrail, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramp work. The overlay is split between two sites:

Site A: Work Completed on Oct. 19. Now Open!

Improvements located at mile post 0.0 of US 24E as it departs US 24 west of the City of Manitou Springs and end at mile post 0.62 (roundabout intersection with Serpentine Drive). This portion has a new surface, new guardrail, and new paint, in addition to the new rehabed Rainbow Falls Bridge.

Site B

Starts at mile post 1.72 (just west of Manitou Springs City Hall) and ends at mile post 2.67 (just east of the US 24 interchange) and includes adjacent Garden of the Gods Place. Thirty ADA ramps will be updated within Site B. Repairs will be made to the concrete deck of the bridge structure located on Garden of the Gods Place. Drainage improvements will be installed at the intersection of Manitou Avenue and Garden of the Gods Place.

Closure and Detour Information

Closure at Garden of Gods Place between El Paso Boulevard and Manitou Avenue from late Sept. to late Nov. 2016. This closure allows bridge, barrier and drainage work to happen concurrently, reducing the duration of disturbance on the road and bike path.

Detour: Manitou Avenue can be accessed from Mayfair Avenue on the west or Beckers Lane on the east. El Paso Boulevard can be accessed from Beckers Lane on the west or Mayfair Avenue on the east.
