### US 24 PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL LINKAGES STUDY

A transportation study of US 24 between Powers Boulevard (SH 21) and the Town of Ramah is underway. The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is conducting a Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study to examine improvements for this important corridor. The study will provide a more thorough understanding of the existing and future transportation conditions along US 24. The study will identify socioeconomic, environmental, and resource concerns and opportunities in the corridor and screen a range of improvements to develop an implementation plan for future projects to meet the operational, safety, and capacity needs of the corridor.

The first phase of this 12-month study includes gathering public input and evaluation of existing and future conditions. The work will be closely coordinated with local agencies, area residents, commuters, and stakeholders to identify transportation improvements that best meet the study goals while considering existing community plans. The project team will be available to listen to your comments and answer questions at the August 16th (Falcon) and August 23rd (Peyton) public meetings.
