



Walsenburg ADA Ramp Project

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation and contract partner Western Gravel Constructors will begin an ADA ramp project on US Highway 160/7th Street, CO 10/5th Street and Interstate 25C/Main Street in Walsenburg on December 16. Ramps will be installed at 23 intersections on US 160/7th St. and CO 10/5th St. starting at Mile Point 304 and will continue for two miles to MP 306 on CO 10/5th St. and on I-25C/Main St. from MP 1-2.

Work will include the removal of existing ramps and installation of 123 ADA compliant ramps. The new ramps will be in compliance with the Public Right of Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) requirements. Work will also consist of improvements to curb ramps, curbs, gutters, and sidewalks.

PROJECT SCHEDULE AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Work is scheduled to begin on December 16, 2020 and is expected to last until November 2021.

Motorists should plan for intermittent side street closures and shoulder closures along US 160/7th St., CO 10/5th St. and I-25C/Main St. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
