Goals of Survey

"Why we did the survey"

1. Determine potential alternate route users.
2. Understand travel patterns in Lamar.

Survey Methodology

"How we did the survey"

1. Each location surveyed from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
2. License plate numbers recorded at each station within 5-minute windows.
3. Correlations made regarding travel patterns and stops through study area.
