



ADA ramp improvements on US 40 in Fraser begin week of Sept. 7

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Next week the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor KSK, LLC will begin ADA ramp improvements on US Highway 40 in Fraser, in Grand County. Work will begin as soon as next Thursday, Sept. 10. The project will improve curb ramps, curbs and gutters, and sidewalks located at several intersections on US 40 (Zerex St.)

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to begin as early as Thursday, Sept. 10 or as late as Sept. 14. The project is expected to continue through late Sept. Normal working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Travelers by car, bike, wheelchair or on foot can expect various lane and sidewalk closures where work zones exist, during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.
- Sidewalks are likely to be closed overnight or over weekends to allow the concrete to set up.
- Access to all businesses will be maintained but may be temporarily altered.
