



ADA Ramp Improvements on US 40 in Winter Park starts August 17

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Starting August 17, the Colorado Department of Transportation and Contractor KSK, LLC will begin ADA Ramp improvements on United States Highway 40 in Winter Park, in Grand County. The project will improve curb ramps, curbs and gutters, and sidewalks located at several intersections on Main Street and US 40.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to begin on August 17 and is expected to continue through late August. Normal working hours will be Monday through Wednesday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m, and Thursday 7 a.m. to 12 p.m.

TRAVEL IMPACTS

- Travelers by car, bike, wheelchair or on foot can expect various lane and sidewalk closures where work zones exist, during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.
- Sidewalks are likely to be closed overnight or over weekends to allow the concrete to set up.
- Access to all businesses will be maintained but may be temporarily altered.
