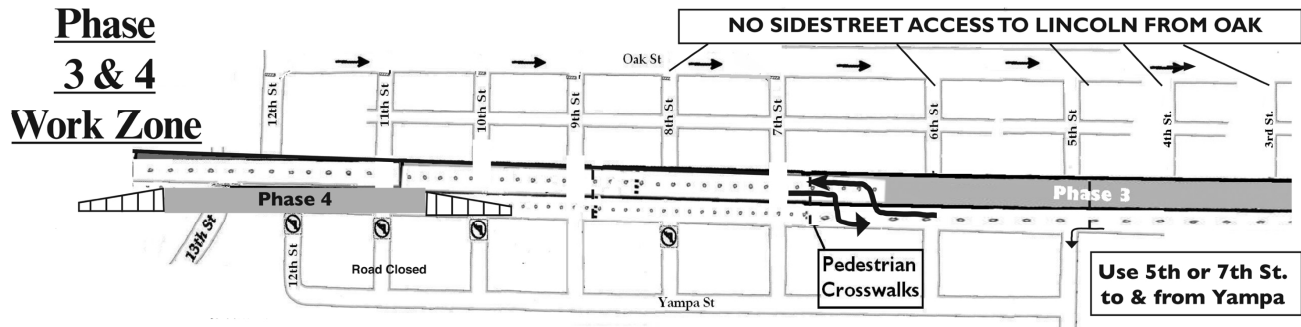




Important: U.S. 40 Reconstruction update For Steamboat Springs

ANTICIPATED WORK ZONES FOR THE UPCOMING WEEK (as soon as Tuesday 6/1, weather permitting): We are essentially done with Phases 1 & 2. Tuesday AM we continue with Phase 3 & start on Phase 4 (south side of 13th!)



TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- 3rd street intersection closed for at least another week.
- Instead, use 7th or 9th (beginning Tues. 6/1?) . Also cross Lincoln Ave. from Old Town to the river at 7th or 9th with uniformed officers during peak commutes & using signals in off-peak times.
- Lefts from Lincoln towards Old Town at 7th or 9th (starting 6/1?)
- Top commitment is getting 5th intersection open in time for Steamboat Marathon Sun. June 6th (it will be on its normal route finishing at courthouse lawn.)
- Lincoln Ave. will be closed overnight for paving 5th -3rd streets Wed. 6/2 7 p.m.-Thurs. 6/3 7 a.m.
- Lincoln Ave. will have hour delays 4 -6 a.m. 6/4 (Fri.) to move the paver into position.
- 10th will reopen Tuesday 6/1.
- Note: 11th and 12th closed to lefts from Lincoln and onto Lincoln while we are in Phase 4 starting Tues. 6/2.
- 13th closed to all turns except rights onto Lincoln from 13th starting as early as 6/1 for at least a week-10 days. Please go back to alternate routes used in Phase 1 (James Brown Bridge) We will be in Phase 4 for remainder of June, but will try to have 13th open ASAP!

Note: Parking and business access is still readily available, accessing from Yampa or Oak streets and via side streets and parking in surrounding lots.

PEDESTRIANS/CYCLISTS: Cyclists and people on foot crossing Lincoln Ave. should not do so in work zones, but should use crossings with flaggers at 5th, and near 7th & 9th . Note: Most sidewalks are open in the area; only crosswalks are closed in active work zones for public safety.

ANTICIPATED SUMMER SUSPENSION & PROJECT COMPLETION DATE: This project will be suspended during July & August, and will resume September 1, 2010. By contract, Scott must complete it by Nov. 12, 2010 or face steep daily fines.
