## US 50/550 Montrose Resurfacing Project

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## Project Overview

- The Colorado Department of Transportation and United Companies have scheduled a resurfacing project in Montrose County along US 50 and US 550 that passes through the city limits of Montrose.
- The project limits are on US 50 from Mile Points 86.0 to 91.70 , including the frontage roads, and on US 550 from MPs 126.4 to 130.1



## Project Schedule

- Work is scheduled to begin on May 15 and is expected to last until September 30, 2022.
- Normal working hours will be Sunday through Thursday night from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.


## Travel Impacts

- Lane closures are only allowed at night.
- No detours anticipated. Motorists may encounter alternating lane closures with wait times up to 15 minutes during night work.
- Two (2) through lanes in each direction and turn lanes will remain open during the day.
- Loads wider than 12 feet will be restricted through the work zone Sunday through Thursday night from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Businesses will be provided with access during their normal work hours.
- Temporary alterations to access may occur during construction hours only.


## US 50 Overlay

## 2-Inch Overlay

- Begins at mile marker 86, located just north of the intersection of 6075/Harvest Road and US 50 between the Town of Olathe and City of Montrose
- Ends at Mile Point 90.89 just north of the entrance to the Montrose Regional Airport.
- This includes the frontage roads.



## US 50 Mill and Fill

## 2.5-Inch Mill and Fill

- Begins at Mile Point 90.89 just north of the entrance to the Montrose Regional Airport.
- Ends at MP 91.7 just north of the San Juan Bypass
- The San Juan Bypass intersection will not be resurfaced.



## US 550 (Townsend Avenue) Mill and Fill

## 2.5-Inch Mill and Fill

- Begins at Mile Point 126.4 near Otter road on south side of the City of Montrose.
- Ends at MP 130.1 just south of the San Juan Bypass intersection
- The Main and Townsend intersections will not be resurfaced.



## Benefits and Safety Improvements

- The project will improve the drivability for motorists on these busy stretches of highway in Montrose County.
- Repairs will be made to the Cedar Wash Bridge, near the south City Market and failed road section at the Encanto Place intersection near Murdoch's.
