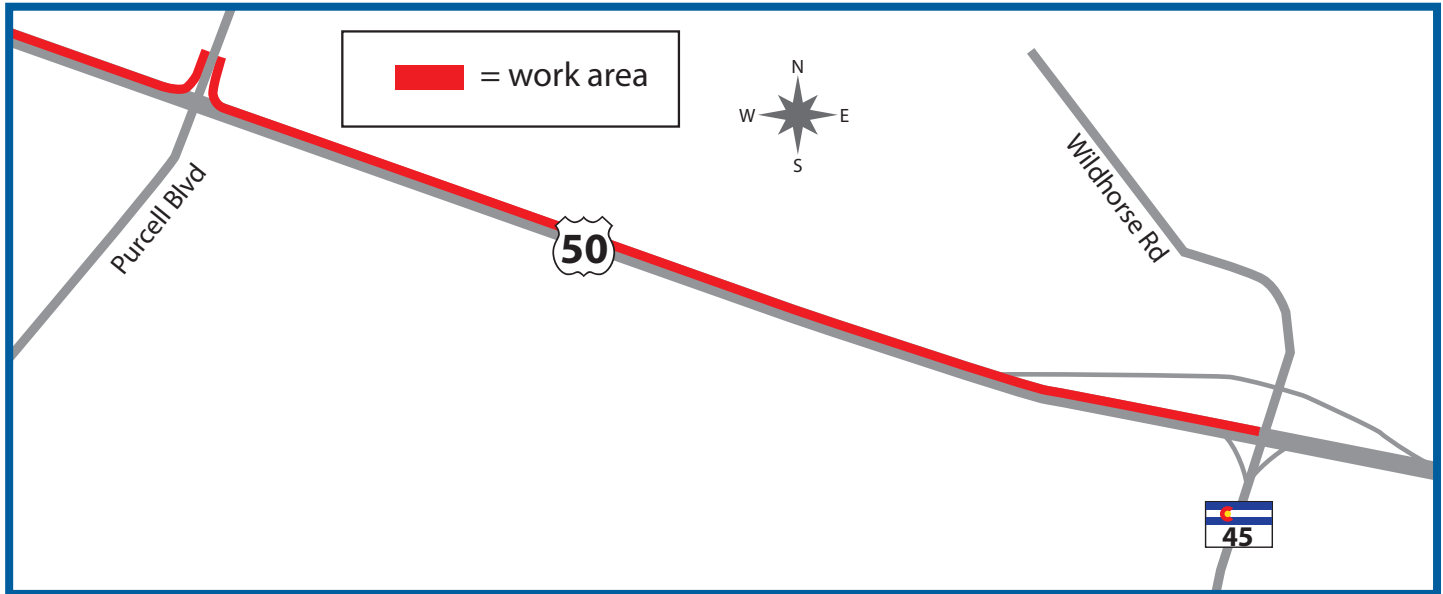




## US 50 PURCELL INTERCHANGE



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation will begin construction in late July on the new interchange at US Highway 50 and Purcell Boulevard in Pueblo West. The first phase of the project is lengthening the third westbound travel lane of US 50 between Pueblo Blvd. and Purcell Blvd. Additional improvements such as sidewalks, curbs and gutter are part of the project design.

These improvements will significantly increase safety on a roadway that carries a high volume of traffic, reduce commuting times for area residents, and allow pedestrians to safely navigate the intersection.

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Work is scheduled to begin in late July and is expected to last until October 2021.

Normal working hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Work during overnight hours can be expected during some phases of the project.

### TRAVEL IMPACTS

During the initial phase of the project, motorists will encounter a night-time closure of the right lane and right shoulder on westbound US 50 beginning at 7 p.m. from Sunday through Thursday evenings as crews set barrier to create the work zone. The right lane will reopen each morning at 6 a.m. The right shoulder will remain closed until construction is nearly complete.

- The **speed limit** will be reduced to **55 mph** through the work zone.
- **Delays up to 10 minutes** can be expected.
