Thank you to those of you who were able to attend the October 26th Context Sensitive Solutions (CSS) Corridor Team Workshop.

Attached you will find the notes we took during the small groups, some of the stories you shared and your words describing the I-70 Mountain Corridor.

Prior to our next workshop, the project team will use the input you provided and your words to craft a Context Statement and Core Values that will guide both the Collaborative Effort's work toward a recommended alternative and the CSS work toward guidelines that will protect what we value the most in the corridor.

The CSS Corridor Team will meet on December 6, 2007 at the Keystone Lodge, the same location as October's meeting.

On December 6, 2007 we will begin at 9:00 a.m. and concluded by 3:00 p.m. We will begin by discussing the Context Statement and the Core Values and how they will guide us forward. Within the next 2 weeks we will send you the Draft Context Statement and Core Values for your review and comments. These documents will also be available on the Web site.

During our December 6, 2007 workshop we will break into small groups to discuss each Core Value and all of the methods we could employ to accomplish that value. Our final task for the day will be to discuss the formation of working groups to tackle some of our detailed issues, such as aesthetic treatments for the corridor.
