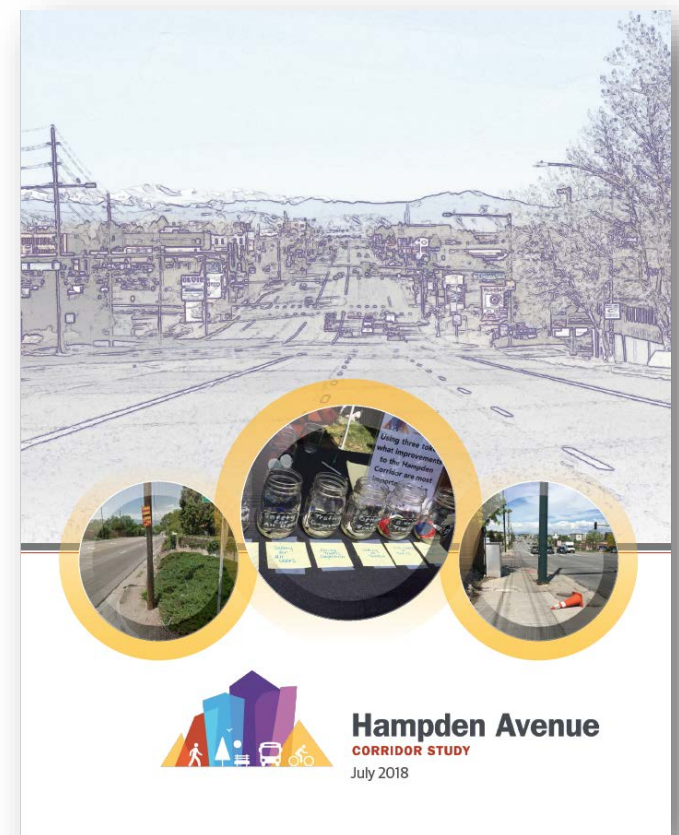




Background

Hampden Avenue Corridor Study (2018)

- Engagement:

 - 3 public meetings
- Key themes:
 - Comfortable and convenient crossings
 - Safety for all modes of travel
 - Complete sidewalk network





Background

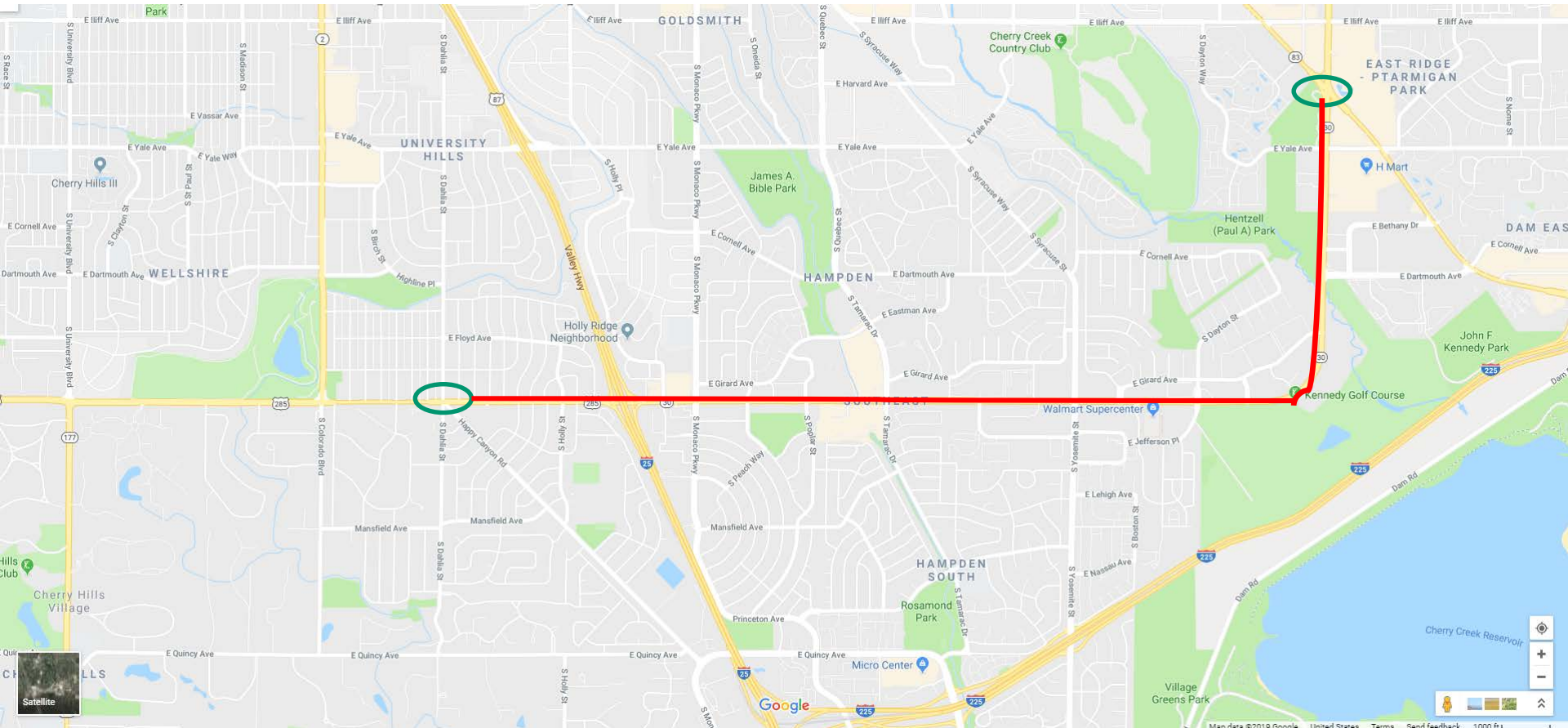
Recommended cross-section east of I-25

- Corridor wide recommendations:
 - Safety counter-measures
 - Raised median
 - Reduce pedestrian crossing distances

Improve Hampden from S. Dahlia St. to S. Parker Road (about 4 miles)

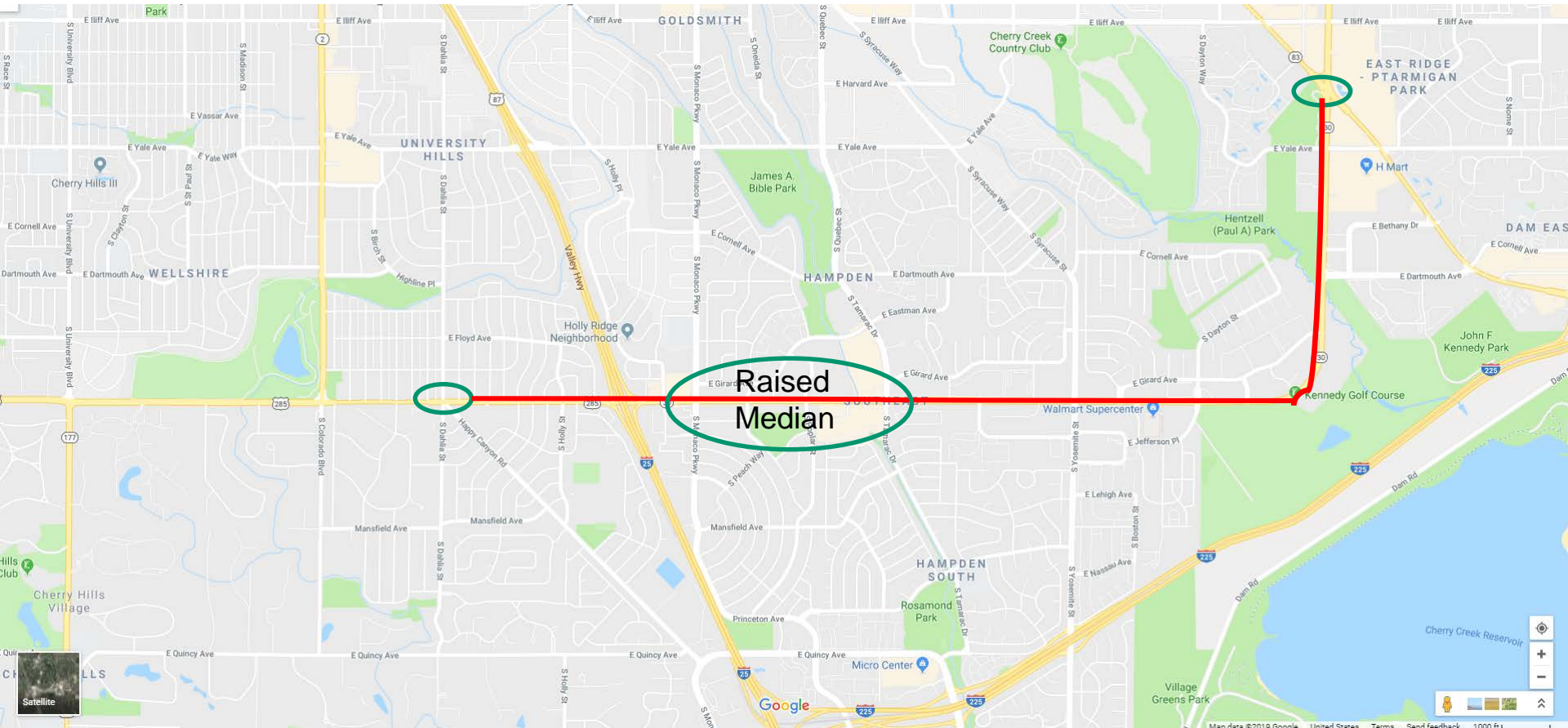
Project highlights

- New pavement driving surface, marking and striping
- Rebuild 107 curb ramps to comply with ADA standards
- Bridge improvements
- Signal equipment improvement
- Fence repairs at Goldsmith Gulch
- Raised median installed between S. Monaco Parkway and S. Tamarac Drive
- Improved pedestrian crossings
- Median cover - color patterned concrete

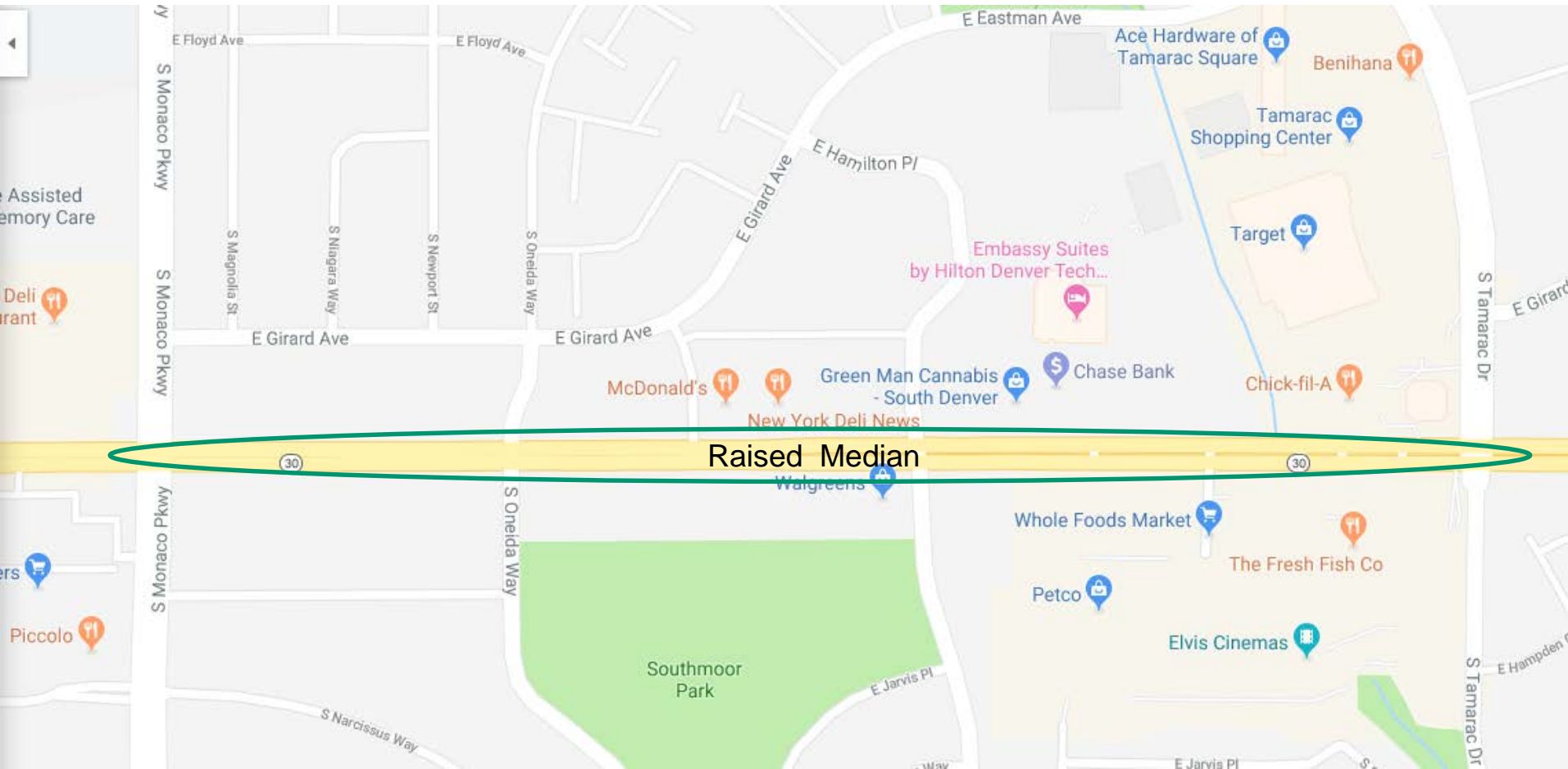
Raised median installed between S. Monaco Pkwy. and S. Tamarac Dr.

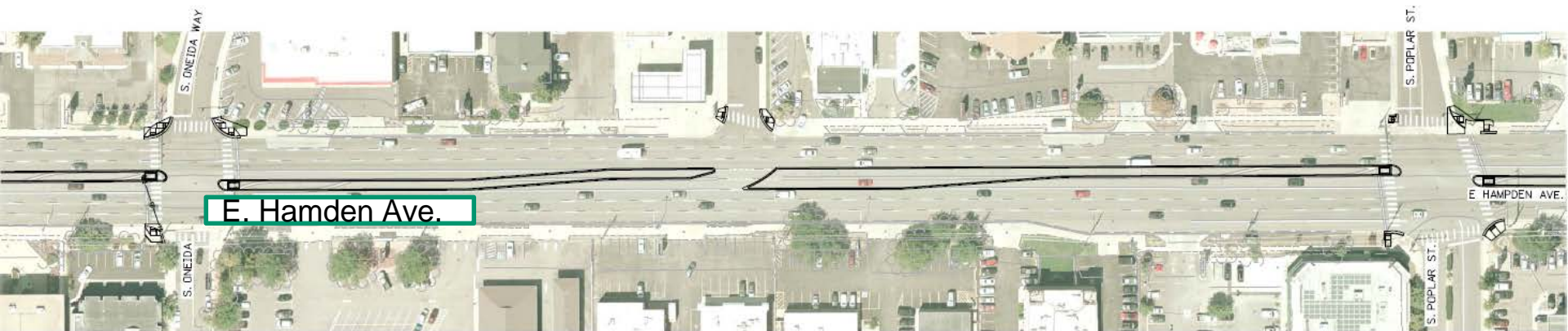
Benefits of raised median

- Leads to improved safety for pedestrians and motorists
- Refuge islands allow pedestrians to cross one direction of traffic at a time
- The FHWA and Transportation Research Board encourage raised medians to reduce car crashes, decrease delays for drivers and reduce vehicle speeds on roadways
- Reduced vehicle speeds help to decrease the rate and severity of crashes

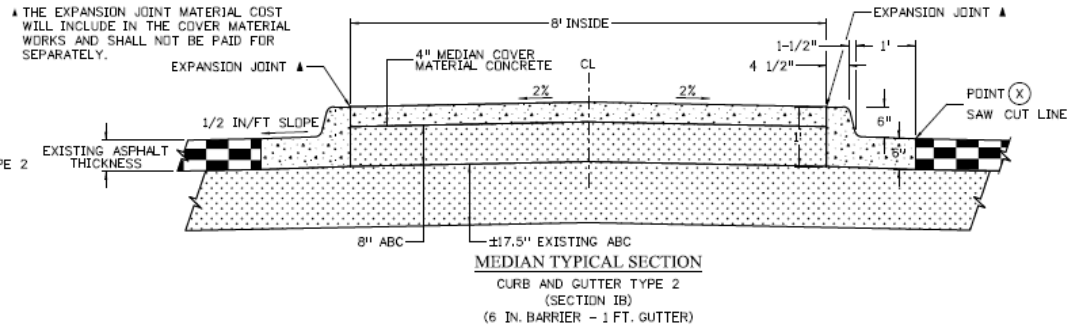
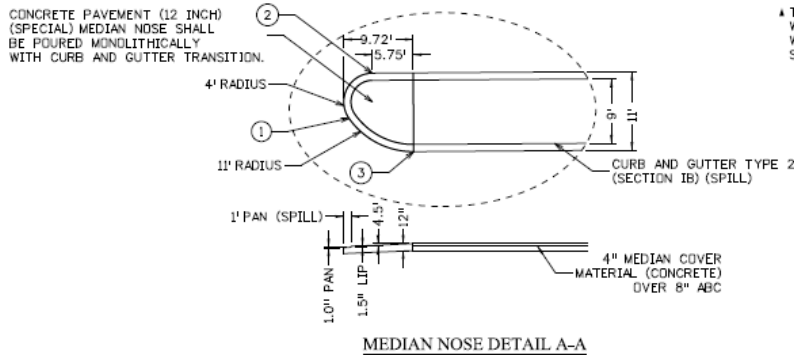
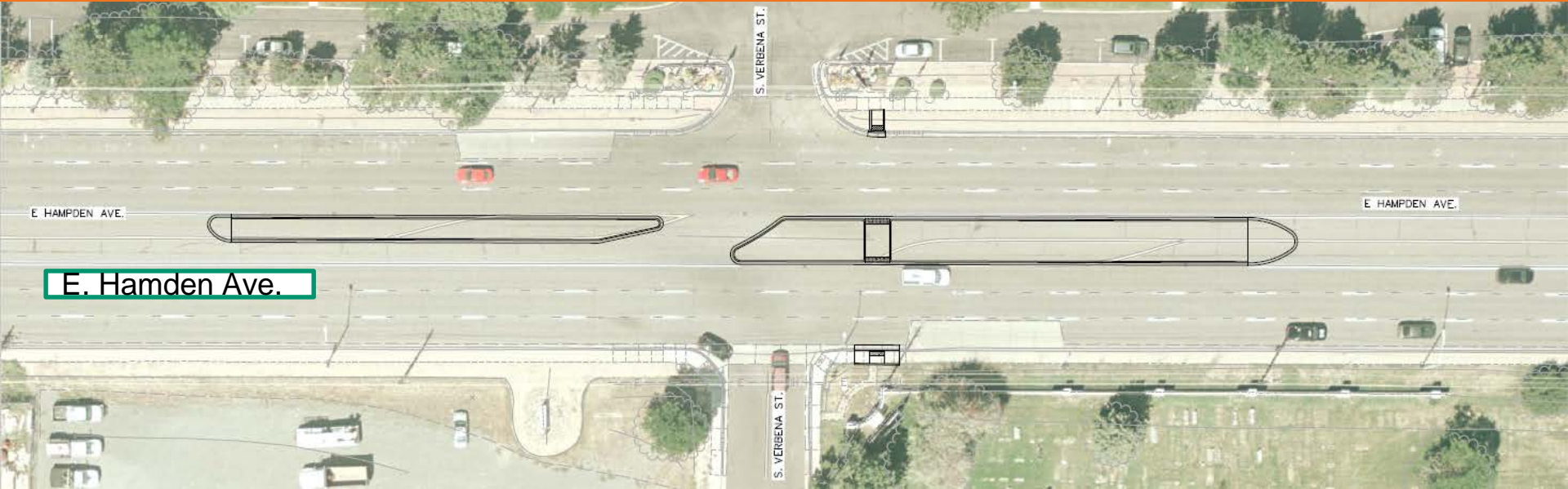
