



PROJECT UPDATE

The Environmental Assessment (EA) for the I-70/Kipling Interchange is complete and is available for public review until February 24, 2019. The EA provides a detailed evaluation of the Proposed Action Alternative (Diverging Diamond Interchange) in comparison with the No Action Alternative.

Public input will be considered by the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration prior to issuing a decision document to finalize the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.

Construction is not yet fully funded, but completing this study and preliminary (30%) design will allow the project to quickly move forward when funding is obtained.
