



I-25 Walsenburg Bridge Replacement

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation will begin an important bridge safety and infrastructure upgrade project on Interstate 25 at Exit 50 in Walsenburg in mid to late March. The site of two bridges, this project consists of building median crossovers to shift traffic, rehabilitating the northbound bridge deck, and removing and replacing the aging southbound bridge which is reaching the end of its lifespan.

Other planned work consists of widening the ramps, relocating a sanitary sewer line, installing guardrail, signs, and delineators, and making other safety improvements to support increased traffic on the I-25 corridor.

LOCATION, SCHEDULE & WORKING HOURS

The project is located on I-25 at Exit 50 (Mile Point 50.055) in the City of Walsenburg in Huerfano County. The bridges cross over Colorado Highway 10 and the BNSF and Union Pacific railroads, serving as a connector to US Highway 160 to the west and CO 10 to the east. The project limits extend for one mile in each direction of I-25, from Mile Point 49 to MP 51.

The project is scheduled to begin in mid to late March and will last for 360 working days or approx. 18 months, with anticipated full completion by late 2024. Project hours will be 30 minutes after sunrise to 30 minutes before sunset, Monday to Friday, with overnight and weekend work expected.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Traffic shifts, single lane closures, reduced speeds, narrowed lanes, detours and width restrictions will be in place on I-25 and CO 10 during various phases of work.
