


Ellston Street and Sinton Trail CLOSED under I-25 for utility work

A complete closure of Ellston Street on Tuesday, Jan. 23 and Wednesday, Jan. 24 during daytime work hours (7 a.m. - 5 p.m.) will impact travelers, including pedestrians and bicyclists. There will be overhead electrical and utility location work. The Sinton Trail under I-25 and the sidewalk at Ellston will be closed during this time.

Detour routes will be in effect during the construction work.

- Vehicle Detour: north on Chestnut Street, right onto Garden of the Gods Road, right onto Sinton Road.
- Bike/Pedestrian trail - alternate routes based on direction you are coming from:
 - South along Chestnut Street. This route will cross I-25 at the Uintah Street interchange and reconnect to the Pikes Peak Greenway Trail using the grade separated crossing on the northside of Uintah Street.
 - North along Holland Park Boulevard to Chestnut Street, north to Garden of the Gods Road, and reconnect to the Pikes Peak Greenway Trail at the grade separated trail crossing east of Pikeview Reservoir.
 - Garden of the Gods Road, south on Chestnut Street, then west on Holland Park Boulevard.
- Ongoing closure: The gravel underpass trail under Chestnut Street is closed during this time. This will remain in effect through late 2024.
