Northbound I-25 Temporary Traffic Split

I-25 WIDENING PROJECT (RIDGEGATE PKWY TO COUNTY LINE RD)

Beginning on Sunday, June 21, the two left lanes will be split from the rest of northbound I-25 to make room for a temporary work zone.

The traffic split starts at the RidgeGate Pkwy (exit 192) off-ramp and continues for two miles to just north of the County Line Rd (exit 195) off-ramp.

This three-week traffic phase allows the project to finish two months earlier.

Traffic split ends here

▲

All on-ramp traffic joins the rest of I-25 north of exit 195 (County Line)

▲

No off-ramp access from the two left lanes until exit 196 (Dry Creek)

▲

Lincoln, C-470/E-470 and County Line exit traffic must be in the two right lanes by exit 192 (RidgeGate)

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

NEED TO NAVIGATE THE TRAFFIC SPLIT?

- ▲ TO: North of County Line
FROM: South of RidgeGate
 - Stay in two left lanes
- ▲ TO: RidgeGate, Lincoln, C-470/E470 & County Line
FROM: South of RidgeGate
 - Stay in right two lanes
- ▲ Ramp to ramp access provided
- ▲ Miss your exit?
 - Exit at Dry Creek, take southbound I-25



During the traffic split, four northbound lanes will provide more capacity than current conditions
