



I-70 over 32nd Avenue Bridge Replacement

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Colorado Department of Transportation will begin a bridge replacement project on Interstate 70 over 32nd Avenue in the City of Wheat Ridge in mid-February 2022. Work includes replacing two bridges and making safety improvements to support increased traffic on the I-70 corridor. Kraemer North America has been selected as the prime contractor for this project.

SCHEDULE & LOCATION

The project is located on I-70 at 32nd Avenue in the City of Wheat Ridge in Jefferson County, Colorado. The work zone extends for half a mile in both directions of I-70 from Mile Point 264.15 to MP 264.65. The project will be performed in five phases and is expected to last until late fall 2023. Work will be performed during daytime hours Monday to Friday with some night and weekend work expected.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Lane shifts, narrowed lanes and reduced speeds in both directions of I-70 will be in place from project kickoff through completion in late fall 2023. Starting in early spring 2022, intermittent single and double overnight lane closures are anticipated in both directions of I-70. A single lane reduction on westbound and eastbound 32nd Avenue at the work zone will also be in place starting in early spring for the duration of the project.
