

Mile High Shift

This spring, as part of the Colorado Department of Transportation's Central 70 Project, eastbound and westbound I-70 will move from the existing viaduct into the future westbound lanes of I-70 in the lowered section between Brighton and Colorado boulevards.

Heading eastbound, I-70 motorists can expect a gradual decline into the lowered section from Brighton Boulevard to approximately Purina. Then, I-70 will level out and gradually incline back to its current elevation by the time motorists reach Colorado Boulevard.

This switch will have motorists traveling under part of the <u>future cover park</u> between Columbine and Clayton streets. Once the Mile High Shift is completed, demolition of the viaduct will begin and continue through the fall.
