because it's more fun and safer, too



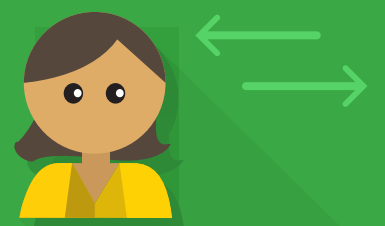
He watches activities from a safe distance
