## York Street and Union Pacific Railroad Crossing Closure (47th Avenue)

Feb. 3, 2019

The York Street and Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) crossing (just north of 47th Avenue) will be closed on Feb. 3 from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. This closure is required so UPRR and Kiewit crews can move the train tracks to line up with the new bridge which is needed as part of the Central 70 Project. York Street will be open by Monday morning.

### TRAVEL IMPACTS

- **Southbound York Street Detour:** Motorists traveling on southbound York Street will be directed to go left on 48th Avenue, south on Brighton Boulevard to connect to eastbound I-70 and exit to York Street.
- **Northbound Josephine Street Detour:** Motorists traveling on northbound Josephine Street will be directed to turn right onto 46th Avenue, then north on Steele Street to connect to westbound I-70 and exit onto Brighton Boulevard. Motorists will then turn right onto 48th Avenue and left onto York Street.
- RTD bus service for the Route 48 will be maintained using the detour.
