



York Street between 45th and 48th avenues will close March 6 - 15 for Xcel Energy utility relocations

York Street will close beginning March 6 for Xcel Energy to complete necessary utility relocations for the Central 70 Project. This work is scheduled to be completed by March 15. Traffic control will be in place to ensure that residents on York Street will be able to access their homes during this closure. Business access will be maintained through this closure but may be altered.

Pedestrians will be able to cross the railroad tracks around 47th Avenue. Traffic control will escort pedestrians through the work zone. There may be delays when work makes it unsafe to cross.

Commuters on I-70 can expect to see traffic impacts during the weekend of March 8, 9 and 10. The center lane in each direction will be closed on I-70 at York Street while this work occurs. The eastbound off-ramp to York Street will remain open during this closure.

Motorists are advised to use the detour seen below while work is occurring. Between 5 p.m. and 8 a.m., one lane will be open on York Street south of 47th Avenue and lanes in both directions will be open between 47th and 48th avenues.

Please drive slowly and be extra cautious through the cone zone.
