



Construction and Community Access

Construction on the Central 70 Project is slated to begin in summer 2018 and last 4-5 years. Given the size and duration of the Project, CDOT has developed a series of measures designed to minimize impacts to the neighborhood and the traveling public.

Construction Requirements

- Three lanes in each direction must remain open during weekday, daytime hours
- Single lane closures on I-70 permitted at night only
- Very limited number of evening/weekend full closures permitted
- Access must be maintained for businesses, adjustments to access may apply
- Limited north/south closures - For instance, Clayton Street won't be closed at the same time as Columbine or Fillmore streets.
- No staging of materials, supplies or equipment within 500 feet of Swansea Elementary School.
- Construction equipment must meet most recent EPA emissions standards

Communication Requirements

The contractor must provide public notification of the following construction activities. Notice will be sent via emails, social media and web posting as well as through signage. Sign up [here](#) for notifications.

Two weeks notice	Full road closures and detours that will last seven days or longer
One week notice	Major project activities that will last seven days or less and other construction including night work, utility relocation, change of business/residential access
24-hour notice	Cancellation of planned closures, major traffic shifts, additional lane closures and other similar activities

Transportation Demand Management

CDOT has contracted with Northeast Transportation Connections (NETC) to provide transportation demand management (TDM) services to the traveling public on I-70 and the surrounding communities before and during construction of the Central 70 Project. This will include:

- Walking, biking and transit solutions including education and training for residents on best and safest routes and programs
- Commuter program coordination with businesses adjacent to the corridor including transit, rideshare and new inventive programs
- Education and training will be offered in numerous languages
