

CDOT is moving forward with the Environmental Assessment and preliminary engineering for the Floyd Hill Project.

CDOT has spent the past 6 months evaluating transportation needs and priorities across the state through [Your Transportation Plan](#), a comprehensive dialogue with residents across the state on transportation needs. The Floyd Hill Project remains a high priority for CDOT to address the operational and infrastructure issues that hamper travel time reliability, safety, and mobility on the I-70 Mountain Corridor.

There is a shortfall for construction funding. CDOT is working with corridor stakeholders to look at creative funding and financing options for the Project and has issued a [Notice to Industry](#) for financial advisory support.

At the same time, the Project team is working to complete the Environmental Assessment and get the Project ready for construction when funds are identified. CDOT will be holding a public meeting early next year to provide more thorough updates on the Project and alternatives under consideration. Stay tuned!
