I-70 Floyd Hill

Project Details

The I-70 Floyd Hill Project will improve eight miles of the I-70 Mountain Corridor, from west of Evergreen to eastern Idaho Springs.

The project will:

- Address the bottleneck along I-70 at Floyd Hill and improve travel time reliability.
- Rebuild bridges to today's safety standards.
- Build a frontage road between US 6 and Hidden Valley/Central City Parkway and straighten I-70 curves to improve safety.


Project Improvements

- Add a third westbound I-70 travel lane in this two-lane bottleneck. This new lane will be a full-time, tolled Express Lane.
- Rebuild bridges due to use, wear and tear, and heavy usage.
- Construct a missing two-mile section of the frontage road between US 6 and the Hidden Valley/Central City Parkway interchange.
- Improve operations by adding an extended on-ramp from US 6 to eastbound I-70, giving trucks room to merge.

Work on several Early Projects identified in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process started in fall 2022 to help improve mobility and safety along the I-70 Mountain Corridor. These projects include:

- Roundabouts along US 40 at County Road 65 and at Homestead Road
- Wildlife underpass at at I-70 and Genesee.
- Wildlife overpass at US 40 Empire.
- Pegasus Transit Shuttle Stop
- Improve traffic flow and access at interchanges and intersections.
- Improve sight distance on roadway curves.
- Improve the Clear Creek Greenway trail.
- Implement environmental mitigation to enhance wildlife connectivity, air and water quality, stream conditions and recreation.
- Install two permanent air quality monitors.





Work on the main project will occur in three sections – East, Central and West. Here are the anticipated traffic impacts during each section of work:

East Section ·

County Road 65 to the bottom of Floyd Hill (Construction began in July 2023).

- Outside widening work along eastbound and westbound I-70.
- Traffic stops in both directions for rock blasting work adjacent to eastbound I-70.
- Overnight lane closures and narrowed lanes and shoulders.

West Section -

Hidden Valley Interchange to Idaho Springs Exit 241 (Construction will begin in early 2024).

- Occasional stops in both directions for rock blasting work.
- Impacts to Clear Creek for bridge removals over the creek.
- Closure of eastbound off-ramp to Hidden Valley during bridge construction.

Central Section ·

Middle of Floyd Hill to Hidden Valley/ Central City Parkway (Construction will begin in spring 2024).

- Traffic shifts in both directions of I-70 to facilitate construction of new bridges.
- Occasional stops in both directions for rock blasting near Hidden Valley.
- Possible overnight closures of I-70, using US 6 and US 40 as detour routes.
- Impacts to Clear Creek and the Greenway trail for bridge construction.
