



I-70 Exit 239 - Timber Soundwall Construction & Miner Street Closure

Project Description: CDOT is replacing the timber soundwall at westbound I-70 Exit 239 (Idaho Springs) and moving it a few feet north to accommodate the construction of a westbound I-70 peak period shoulder lane. One block of Miner Street will be closed to through traffic for equipment staging.

Miner Street Closure: Miner Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue at the westbound I-70 Exit 239 off-ramp will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic will be granted access to driveways. Detour signage is in place.

Schedule: Work began Feb 3 and will last for approx. 8 weeks. To expedite construction of the soundwall, crews will be working 7 days a week between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Some night work may also be required. All construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change.

Coping with Construction: Residents are encouraged to contact us with any concerns about the construction schedule, right of way access, or other issues.



CDOT is moving this timber soundwall at westbound I-70 Exit 239 a few feet to the north to accommodate construction of a new westbound I-70 peak period shoulder lane from the Veterans Memorial Tunnels to the Empire Junction.

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
