





#131 Colorado Random Reveal




Corridor Stain Color intended to Match Weathered Rock faces

Revegetated Slopes will break-up Bottom of Wall


2' Precast MSE Coping Joints Alternate with Panels

Full Height MSE Walls Colorado Random Texture creates Shadows while camouflaging Panel Joints


Walls derived from Typical Section






Barrier in Z-Slope




