

PERMANENT FRONTAGE ROAD CLOSURE BETWEEN PROSPECT ROAD AND MULBERRY STREET

On Monday July 6, the I-25 frontage road between Prospect Road and Mulberry Street will close permanently to allow for the expansion and additional lanes on I-25 North. Business access will be maintained on the frontage road off of Mulberry Street. Through access will no longer be available.

When the I-25 North Project: Johnstown to Fort Collins is complete in 2024, it will add an Express Lane in each direction of I-25, replace aging bridges, make interchanges safer and more efficient, and improve infrastructure for bus transit along the I-25 corridor. The nearly \$450 million project will also add carpool and transit facilities, create new pedestrian and bicycle access under I-25 at Kendall Parkway, improve drainage systems and improve the alignment of I-25 for safer travel as part of CDOT's Whole System – Whole Safety initiative.
