## Region 2 Bridge Bundle Project

**The \$43 million Region 2 Bridge Project will consist of replacing five structures on US 24, nine structures on US 350 and three structures on CO 9.**

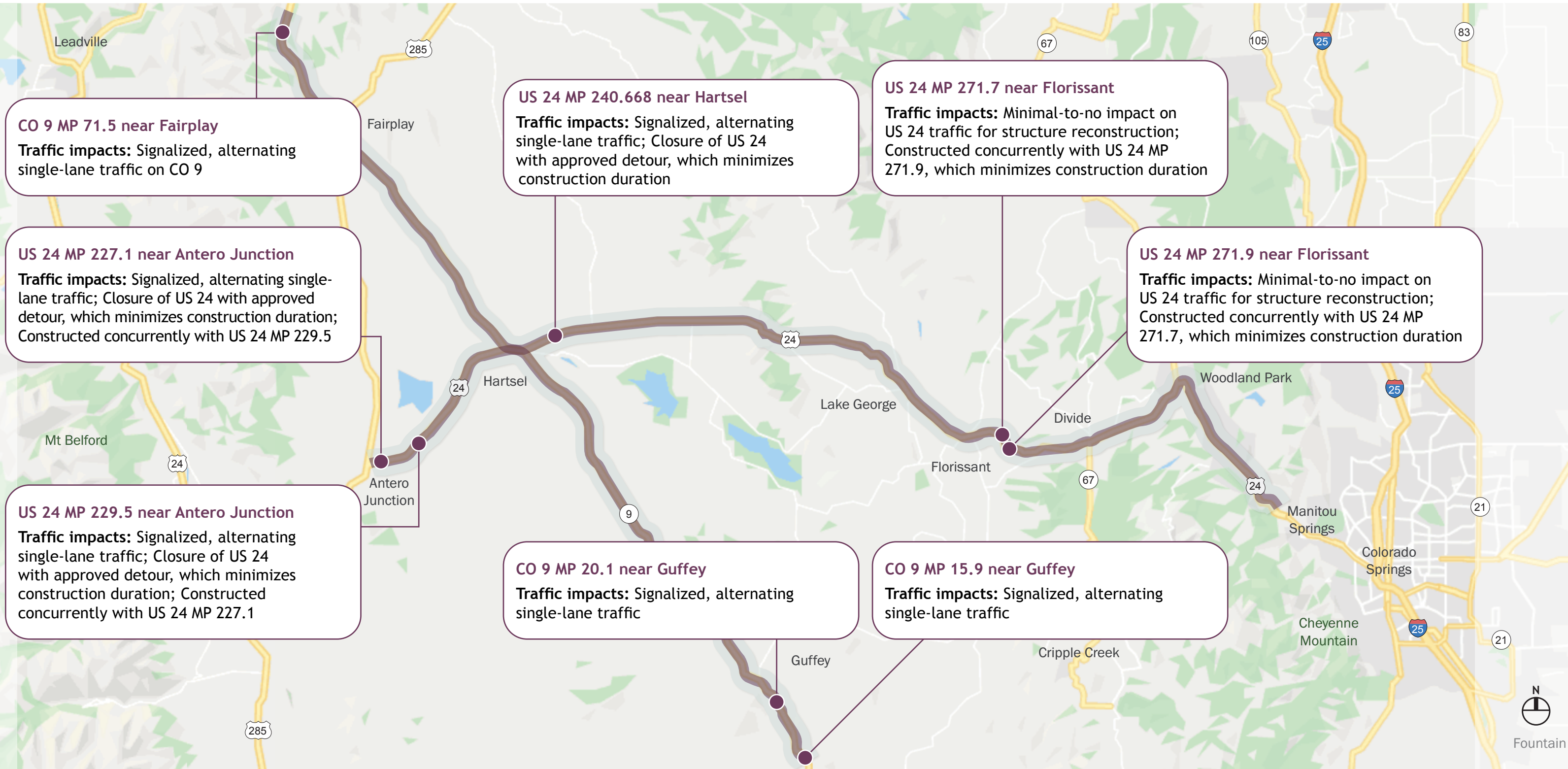
These key corridors provide rural mobility, intra- and interstate-commerce, movement of agricultural products and supplies, and access to tourist destinations.

**US 350 MP 10.3 near Hoehne and Trinidad**  
**Traffic impacts:** Signalized, alternating single-lane traffic



**US 350 MP 56.5 near Timpas**  
**Traffic impacts:** Signalized, alternating single-lane traffic; Closure of US 350 with approved detour; Constructed concurrently with US 350 MP 57.1 and 57.5

**US 350 MP 57.1 near Timpas**  
**Traffic impacts:** Signalized, alternating single-lane traffic; Closure of US 350 with approved detour; Constructed concurrently with US 350 MP 56.5 and 57.5

**US 350 MP 57.5 near Timpas**  
**Traffic impacts:** Signalized, alternating single-lane traffic; Closure of US 350 with approved detour; Constructed concurrently with US 350 MP 56.5 and 57.1

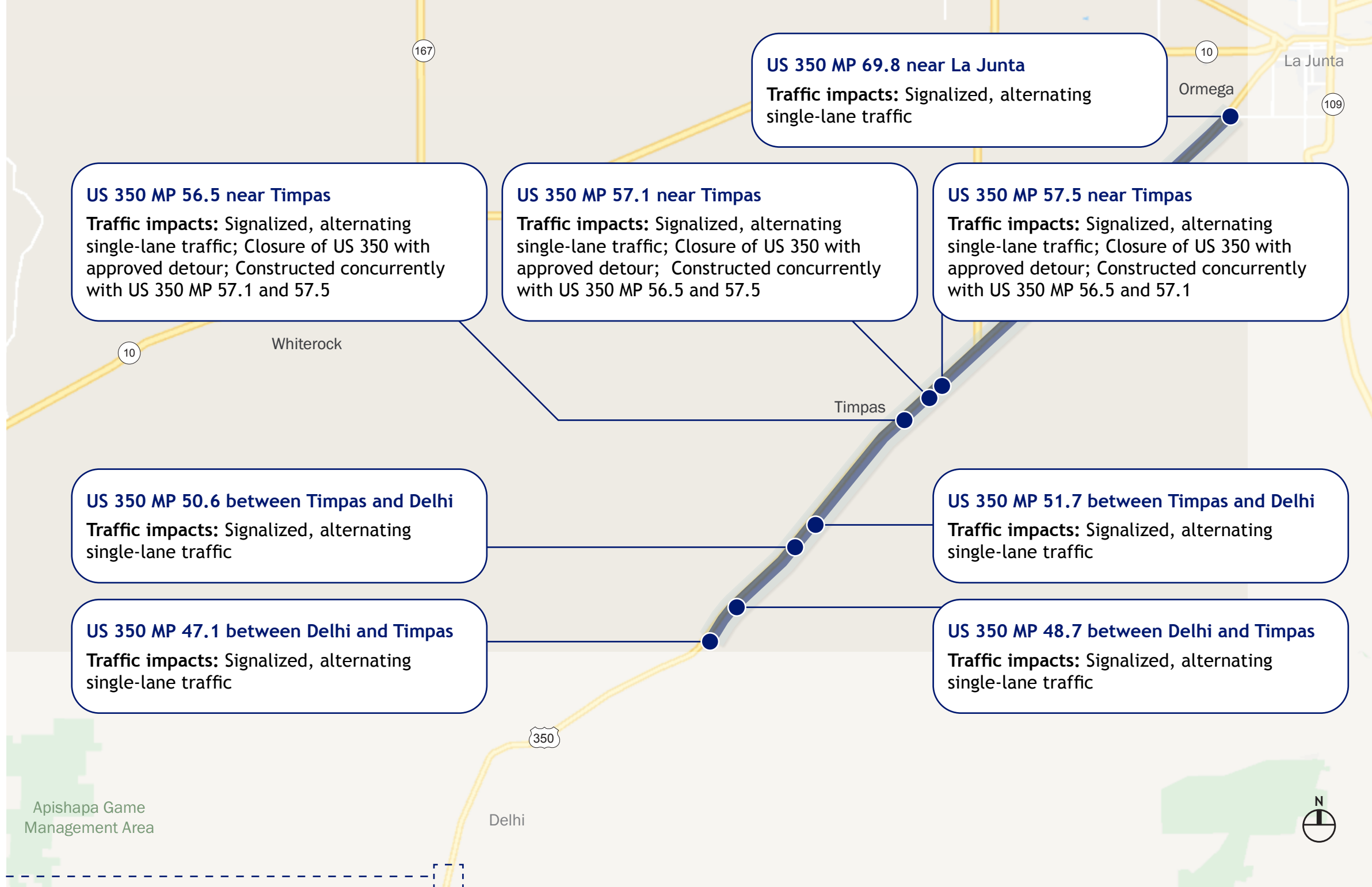
**US 350 MP 50.6 between Timpas and Delhi**

# INITIAL PROJECT IMPACTS



## Region 2 Bridge Bundle Project

### **In July 2022, crews will begin to mobilize equipment for structure replacement on CO 9 and US 350.**

In the Mountain region, construction will begin on the CO 9 structure at MP 15.9 near Guffey.

Following mobilization, crews will begin signalized, alternating single-lane closures for structure replacement.

In the Plains region, construction will begin on three US 350 structures near Timpas:

- MP 57.5
- MP 57.1
- MP 56.5

There will be little to no impacts to traffic as crews mobilize equipment.

# TRAFFIC IMPACTS



## Region 2 Bridge Bundle Project

**As crews construct these 17 structures, crews will work to minimize traffic impacts to the public. Expected impacts include:**

- Signalized, alternating single-lane traffic on CO 9, US 24 and US 350
- 21-day full closure of US 350 with detour near Timpas
  - Between September and October 2022
- 14-day full closure of US 24 with detour near Hartsel
  - Between September and October 2022
- 21-day full closure of US 24 with detour near Antero Junction
  - Between spring and summer 2024
