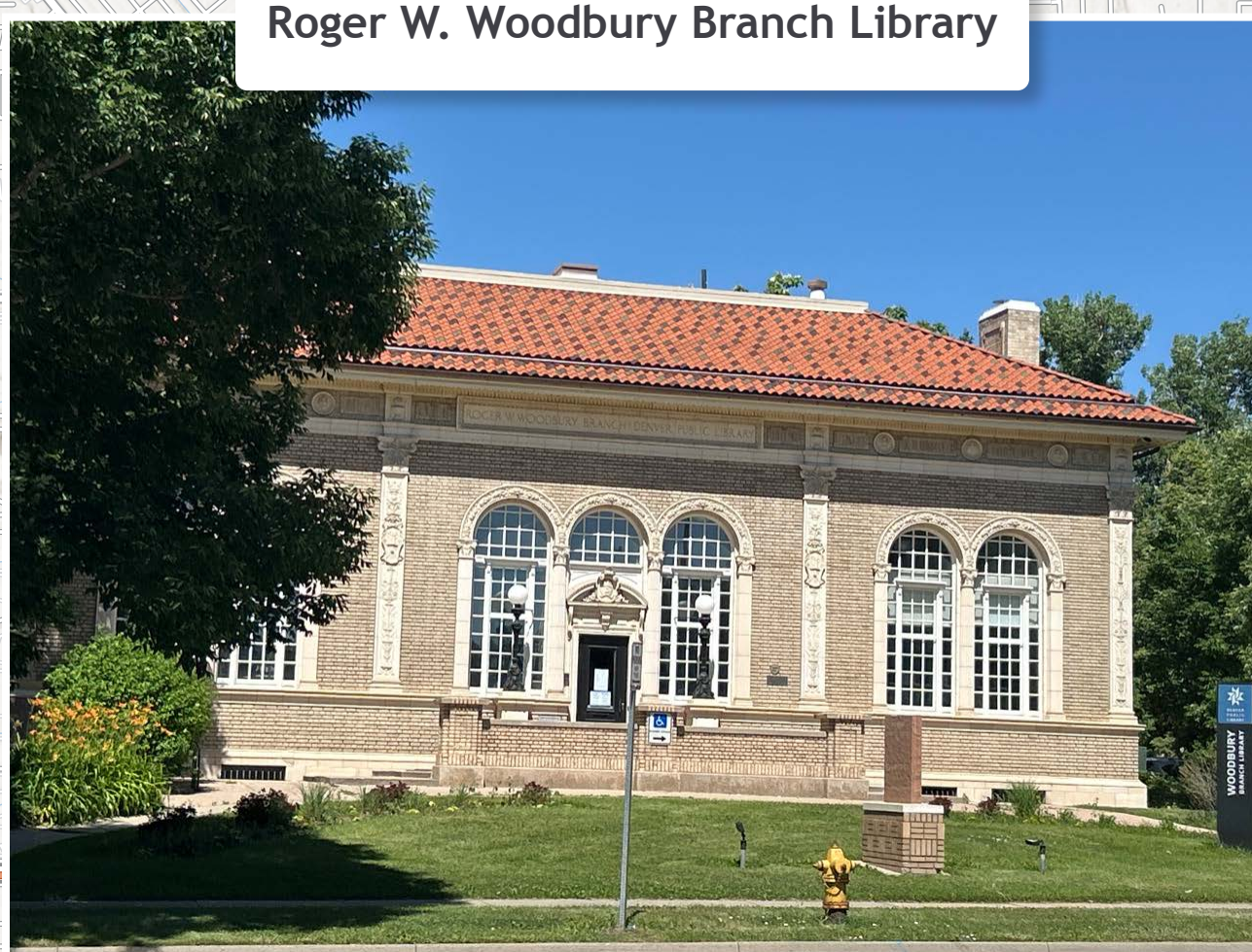


Historic Resource Analysis

An historic resources analysis is being conducted to **identify historic properties along the project corridor and to find ways to avoid, minimize, or mitigate potential effects.** The historic analysis is required for compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (NHPA) and U.S. Department of Transportation Act requirements. This process involves defining the project's Area of Potential Effects (APE), which defines the geographic area where potential effects to historic resources may occur, identifying properties listed and/or eligible to the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) within that APE, and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) will be consulting with the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and other consulting parties on potential effects to known historic resources. This board illustrates some of the known NRHP eligible or listed properties in the project's APE boundary.

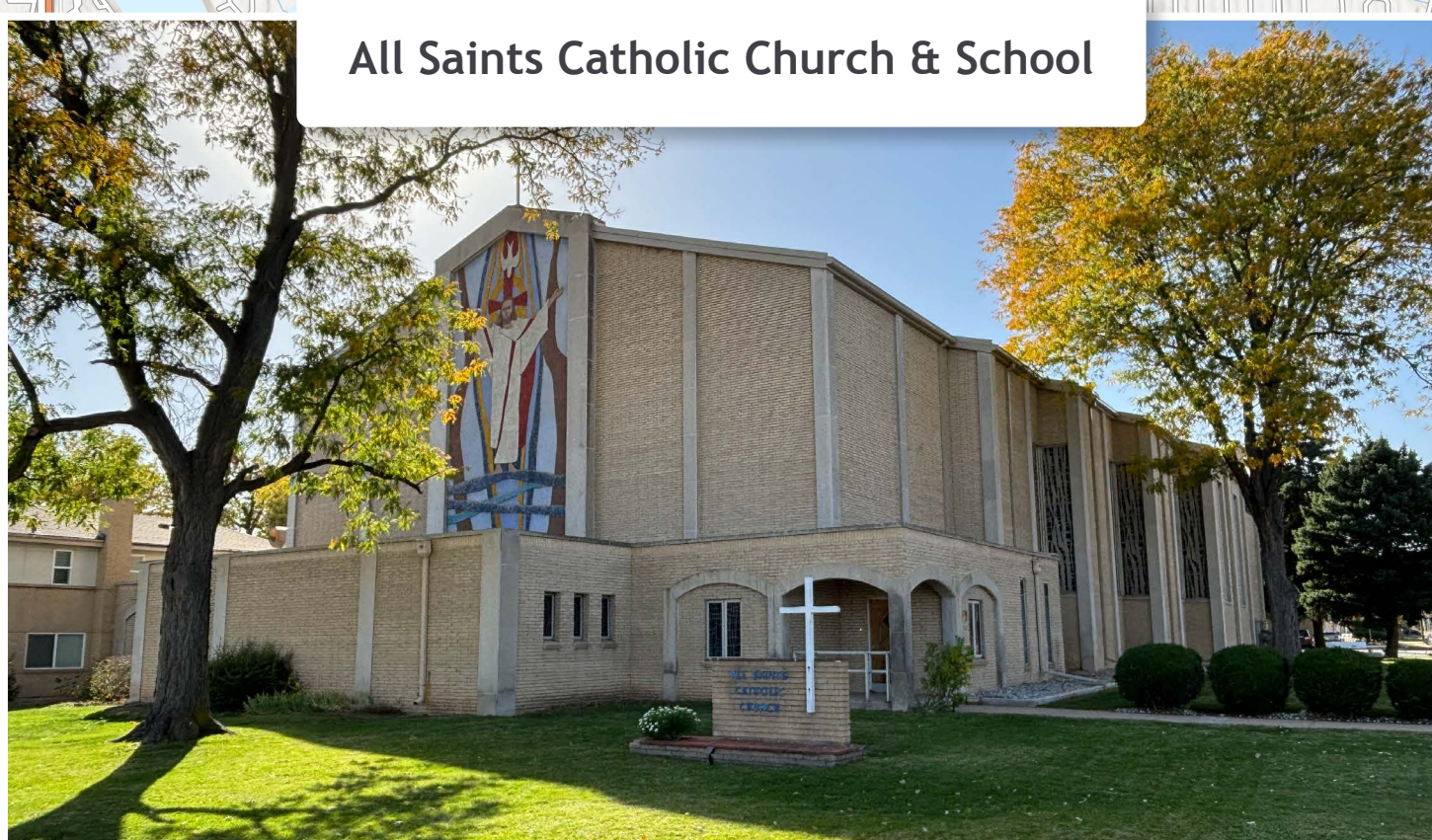

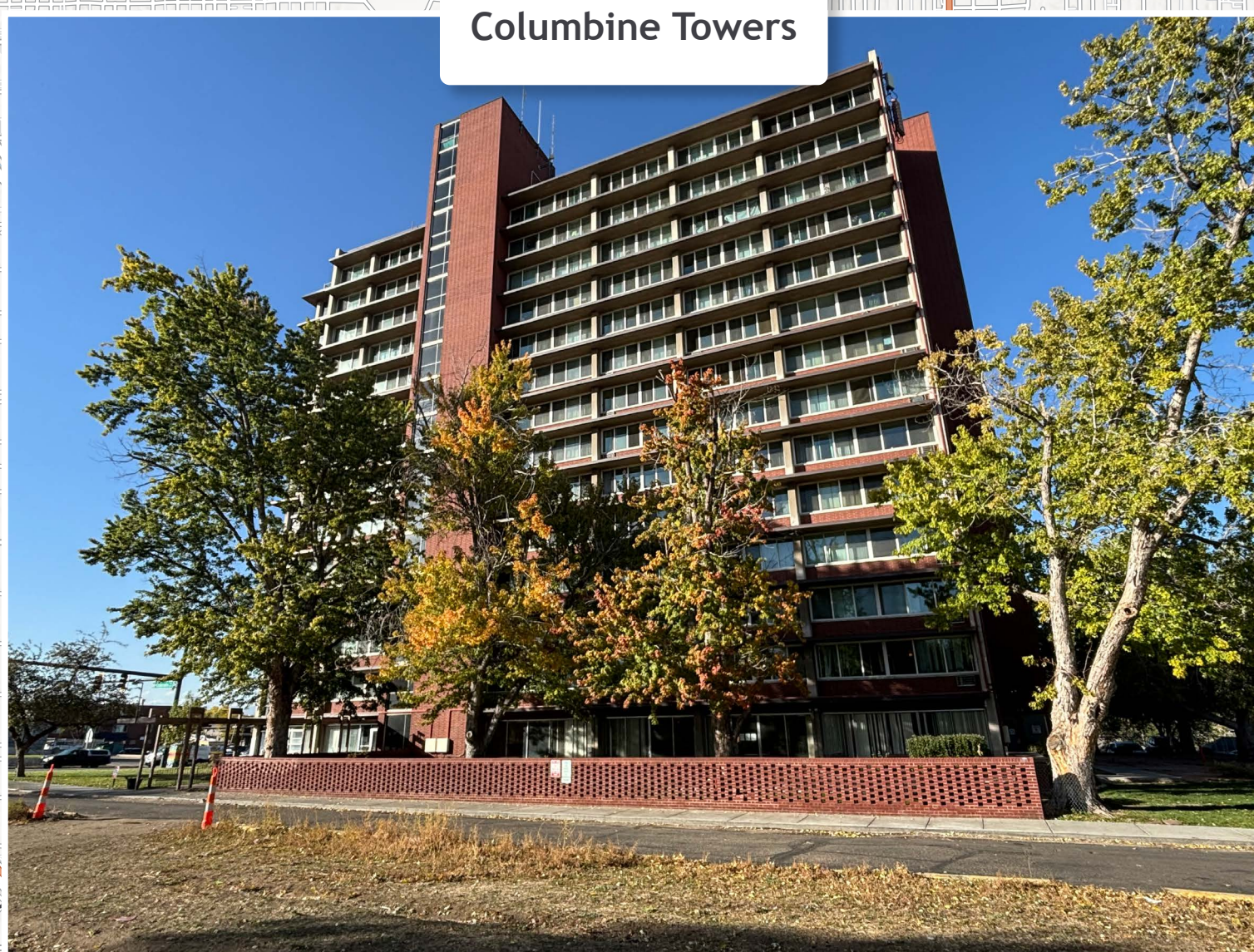
