

Business Owner Feedback



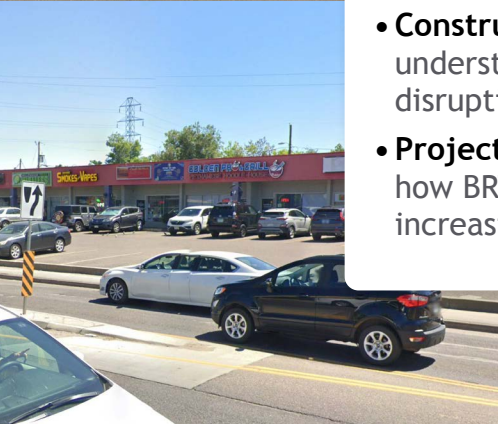
Local business owners have played an important role in shaping the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) project. Their input has helped the project team better understand how improvements can support both transit users and the local business community.



Throughout the planning process, business owners have shared feedback during the initial set of public meetings, through focused outreach events, and at a recent property owner meeting hosted by the project team.

Key themes from this input include:

- **Property and Right-of-Way Impacts:** Business owners want clear information on whether the project will affect their property lines, access points, or frontage areas.
- **Customer Access:** Maintaining convenient access for customers before, during and after construction is a top priority.
- **Visibility from the Street:** Businesses value being visible to passing traffic and want to ensure that new transit infrastructure complements—rather than obstructs—their storefront visibility.
- **Construction Duration:** Business owners are interested in understanding the construction schedule and how potential disruptions will be minimized.
- **Project Benefits:** Many expressed interest in learning more about how BRT can benefit their business by improving customer access, increasing street activity, and supporting corridor vitality.
