
Safety Need

Improve safety for all modes of travel (transit, vehicular, pedestrian, bicyclists, etc.) along the corridor.



Federal Boulevard has more crashes than similar busy streets in Colorado. Most involve property damage, but many also cause injuries and some result in deaths. Common crash types include rear-end, broadside, and turning collisions at intersections, with sideswipe crashes being a particular problem in the southern part of the corridor.

Proposed Safety and Accessibility Improvements:


- Enhanced crosswalks
- Upgraded station areas
- New or improved sidewalks



How will the project determine if Federal BRT meets this need?
