



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



Alternative 3: Add Managed Lanes (ELMP)




Ultimate Vision vs Project

- Ultimate Vision
 - Considers all needs and recommendations from I25 Central PEL, from 20th to 17th.
 - Braided ramps/CD roads
 - Express Lane facilities
 - Other operational/safety improvements
 - Local cross-connectivity
 - Determining the ultimate vision for the area ensures bridge replacements will not preclude improvements.
- Project
 - Structure replacement
 - Other elements to be included based on significance, funding, and strategy

Structure Replacement	• Bridge structures that meet current design standards for adequate clearance, structural sufficiency, and a span to accommodate a future managed lane system
Safety	• Safety improvements that reduce the number of crashes.
Operational Improvements	 Operational improvements that reduce congestion
Bike/Ped Improvements	 Pedestrian and bicycle facilities that are safe, accessible, and comfortable



- Substandard Condition of Bridges over I-25
 - Vertical clearance of 13'-9" on 23rd and 13' 5" on Speer which does not meet the standard of 16' 6"
 - Deck conditions rated as poor
 - Load capacity does not meet the current standard
 - Cracking and spalled concrete with exposed rebar is present throughout concrete deck



• Multiple Areas with Insufficient **Ramp Spacing** EER BLVD 23RD AVE COLFAX AVE


 Areas with Lane and Shoulder Width Deficiencies






Project Need: Safety

Northbound I-25






Southbound I-25






• Future (2040) Mainline and Ramp Volumes Exceed Available Capacity





- Peds and bikes on 23rd and Speer Blvd must cross multiple uncontrolled ramps to fully cross I-25
- Most existing bike and ped crossings are uncomfortable
- Examples:
 - Peds on 23rd Ave must navigate a section without sidewalk
 - Bikes on the 23rd Ave bike route must navigate narrow lanes without a buffer between a travel lane and guard rail on the bridge
