- a. Scope
 - i. Addition of EB Auxiliary Lane from Exit 203 through Exit 205
 - i. Add 3rd lane/Aux Lane
 - ii. Widen Structures
 - i. Widen 2 structures into median
 - iii. Overlook Access
 - i. Will include 6 additional large vehicle parking spots and reconstruct sidewalk
 - v. Wildlife Fencing
 - i. Exist 203 to west end of Blue River Parkway both directions of I-70
- b. EB Auxiliary Lane Project Design Schedule
 - i. Scoping Meeting: May 14, 2020
 ii. FIR Meeting: December 10, 2020
 iii. 50% Design Review: April 2021
 iv. FOR Meeting: July 22, 2021

- 5. Design Review
 - a. Review Widening locations
 - i. Siphon No Impacts, protect-in-place and reconnect drain pipe to proposed storm drain system
 - b. Exit 205 Off-Ramp
 - i. MIMR Approved in Jan 2021
 - c. Pier protection on US 6
 - i. Construction phasing/lane closures
 - 1. Use Forest Service Brown for color of pipe railing
 - 2. Action item Send Plans to Town of Silverthorne
 - 3. Recommended to start work after April 18th (after Easter and Keystone ski season)
 - 4. Use nighttime closure windows for one lane each direction on one side of bridge (routed through intersections on either side), for micropile foundation installation (most disruptive work). Recommended to use working time allowance of 9 PM to 6 AM for that work.
 - d. Scenic Overlook
 - i. Six additional parking spots
 - ii. Close during construction for contractor staging area
 - 1. Closed late Spring to November 1st and back open through winter, close again April 1 until project is complete
 - iii. Sidewalk Exposed Aggregate vs Standard
 - 1. Action Item USFS will check with Landscape Architect to see if any concerns with standard concrete
 - e. Bridge Widening
 - i. Blue River Pier
 - ii. Trail realignment Section 4(f) De Minimis letter received from Town of Silverthorne
 - iii. Construction phasing No concerns with trail phasing or Stephens way impacts
 - f. Wildlife Fencing
 - i. Mishler Trail not impacted

- 1. Action Item USFS is looking into potentially removing from travel management plan
- ii. Action Item WSP to send out final fence plans and KMZ, Include current M-Standard with questions on using 3:1 slope up game ramp and 5.5 feet vertical drop height
- g. Construction Schedule
 - 2 Season Construction Project, Project team is working on developing schedule with construction milestones. One recommended milestones was lane restrictions on US 6 to be completed by Mid-June.
- 6. Mountain Corridor Design Criteria
 - a. Review and Approve Corridor Design Exceptions Memo (attached to meeting minutes)
 - i. Side Slope Use of 2:1 Max side slope
 - ii. Widening to Median Minor widening into median, would not preclude future AGS.
 - iii. Bridge Format Minor use of slope paving and matching existing abutments as part of bridge
 - b. Question and discussion on Noise Analysis post project. Noise analysis is completed to identify project impacts and mitigation, it is not updated when future development occurs, or objections are raised.
 - c. No Objections to Design Exceptions. Considered approved by PLT
