TELEPHONE TOWN HALL PUBLIC MEETING RESULTS:

CDOT held a Telephone Town Hall Meeting on Wednesday June 12, 2013 from 6PM to 7PM regarding the most recent study that has been initiated for the I-225 improvements between Yosemite Street and I-25. This event was very successful in getting the word out about the study and answering questions from the public. CDOT reached out to more than 11,000 people in the vicinity of the project with about 1000 people participating in some capacity. The most number of people engaged in the town hall at one time included more than 360 individuals, which occurred during the presentation. We also had seven polling questions that were asked during the town hall. We have included the questions and responses on the website.

Our next meeting will be a public open house to share with you the alternative concepts developed and a short-list of those to study further to arrive at a solution to improve congestion on southbound I-225 between Yosemite and I-25. Watch the website for more information as it becomes available.
