Corridor users and residents are engaged with CDOT to find an immediate solution to transportation issues in the corridor

- I-25 corridor links the state's two major metropolitan areas and is critical to economic and business development for the state.
- Many residents and businesses rely on this critical corridor every day.
- Improvements to I-25 are the top transportation priority for Colorado Springs.
- Safety improvements in the corridor are critical!
- Delays & congestion on I-25 extend from the weekdays to the weekends; and delays are worse in the two-lane section.
- Spill over congestion to the frontage roads impacts business, residents and open space users.
- Near-term solutions are needed! Ten years is too long for a solution.
- Fix the "gap"!
- The "gap" section needs a third travel lane immediately.
- Consider a long-range vision for the corridor but examine temporary operating solutions now.
- Move design forward so we are ready to fund.
- We will find the funding!
- Can you run concurrent PEL and NEPA processes? Let's not waste time.
- We want to see some action – can we pave the shoulder?
- Transit needs to play a bigger role in the corridor.
- The culture of driving is changing and other mobility options are important.
